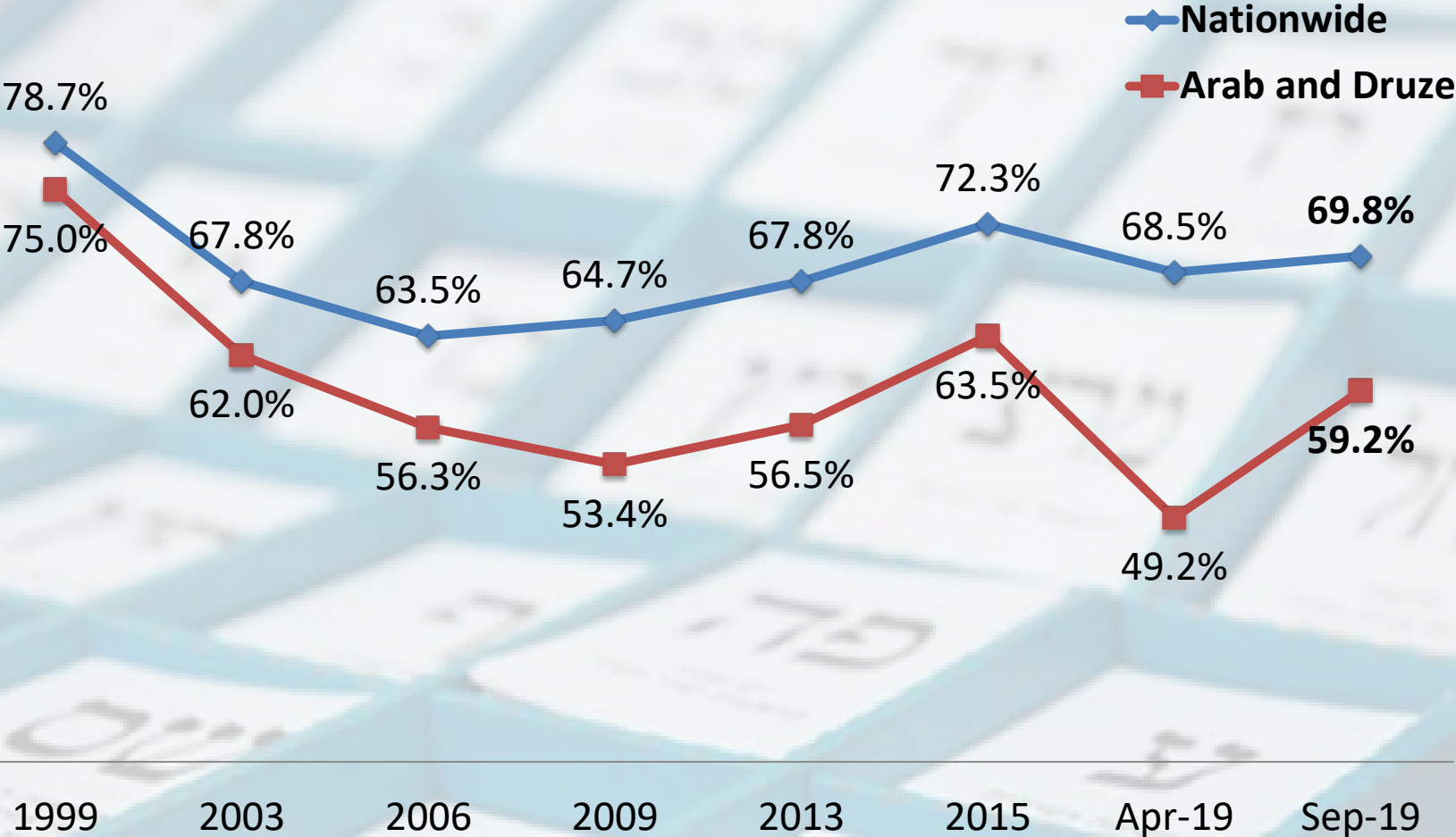

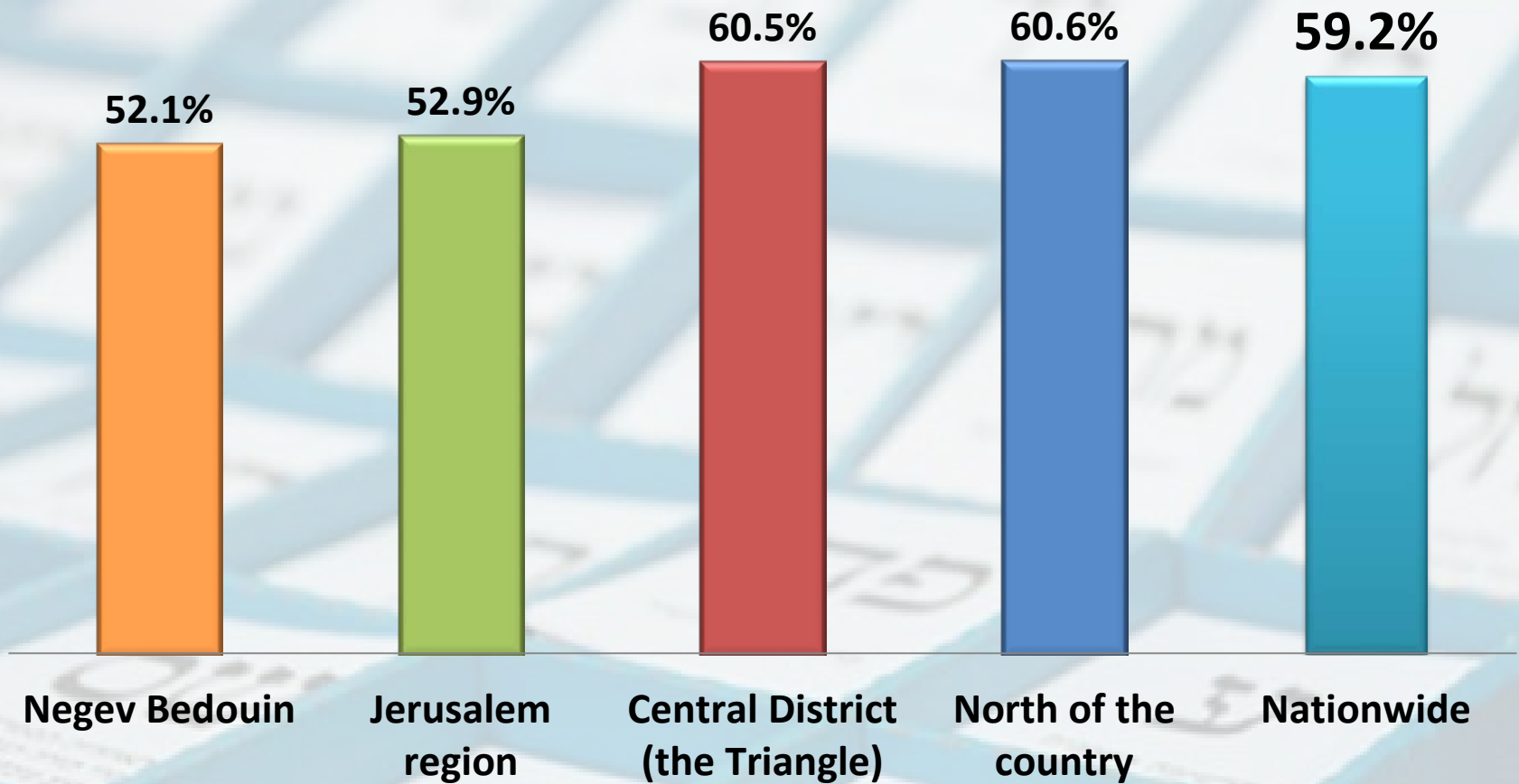

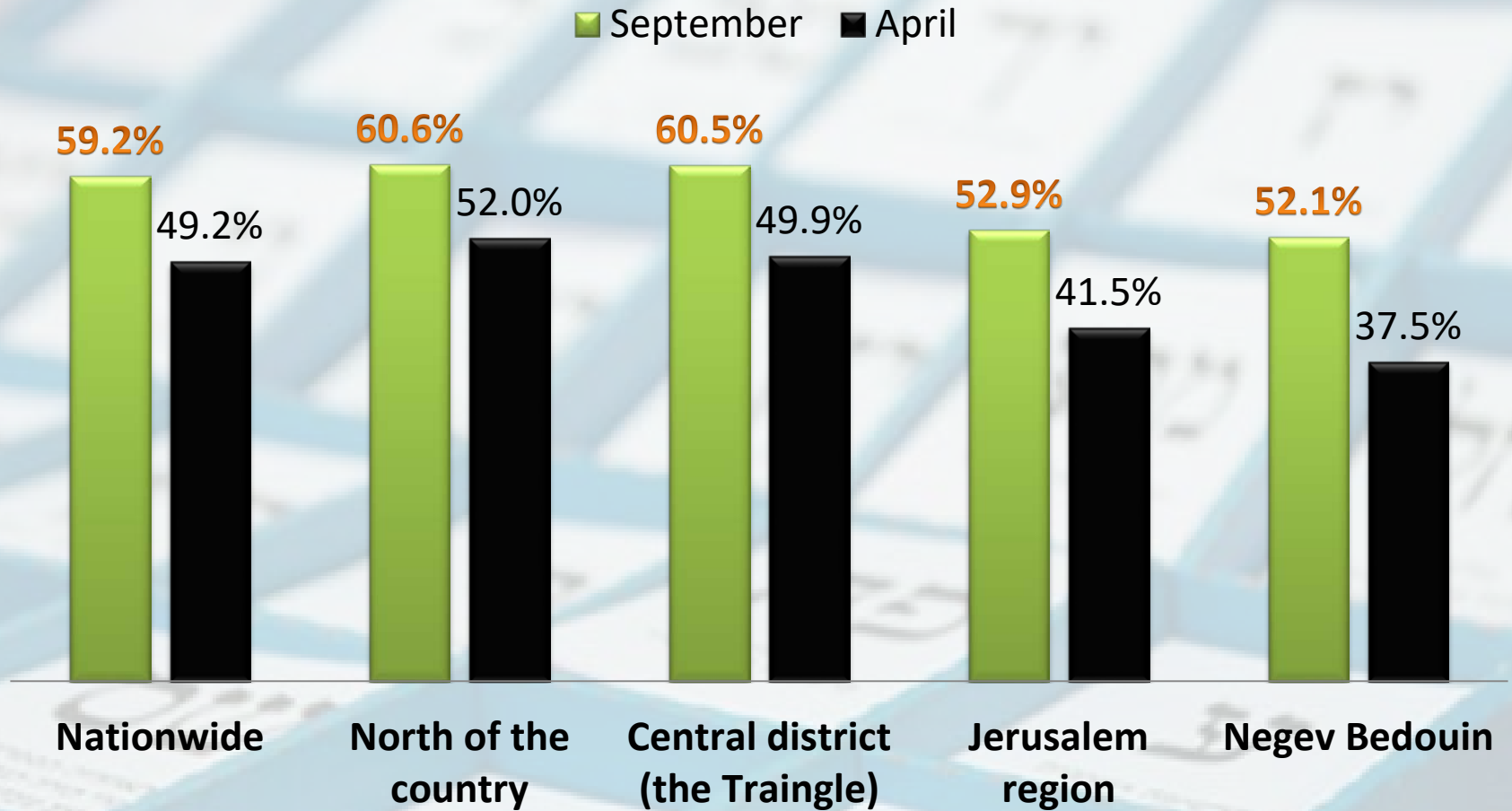

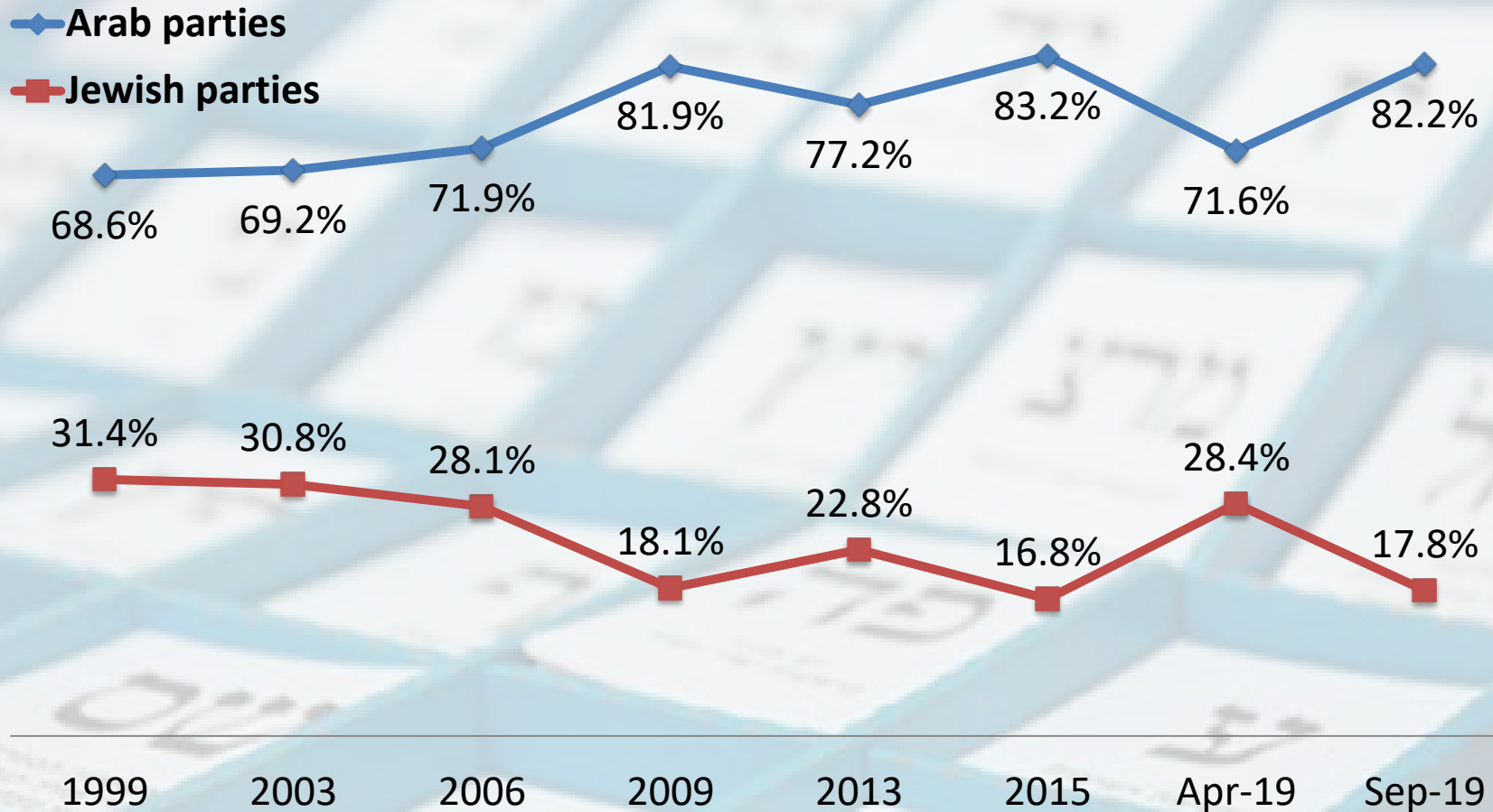

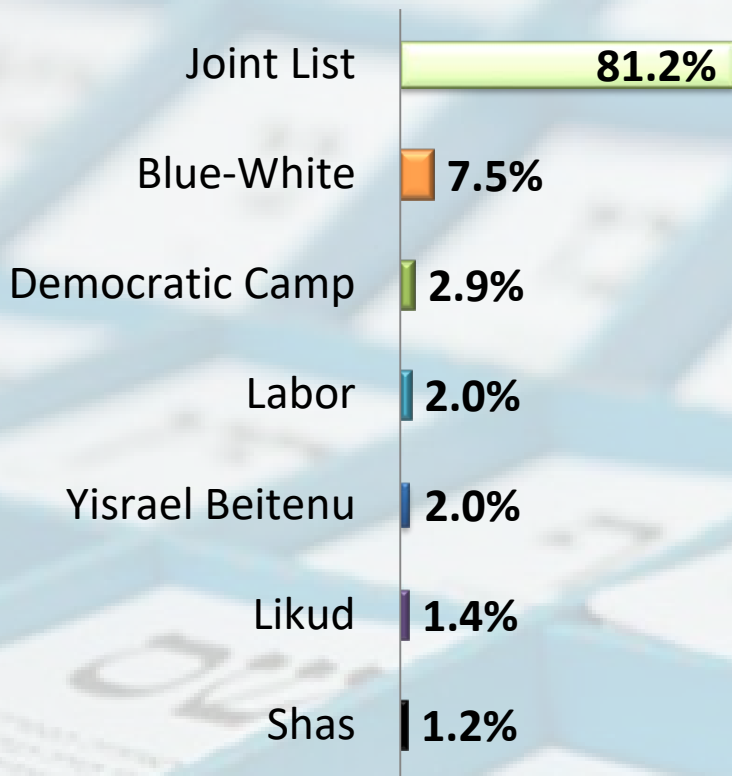

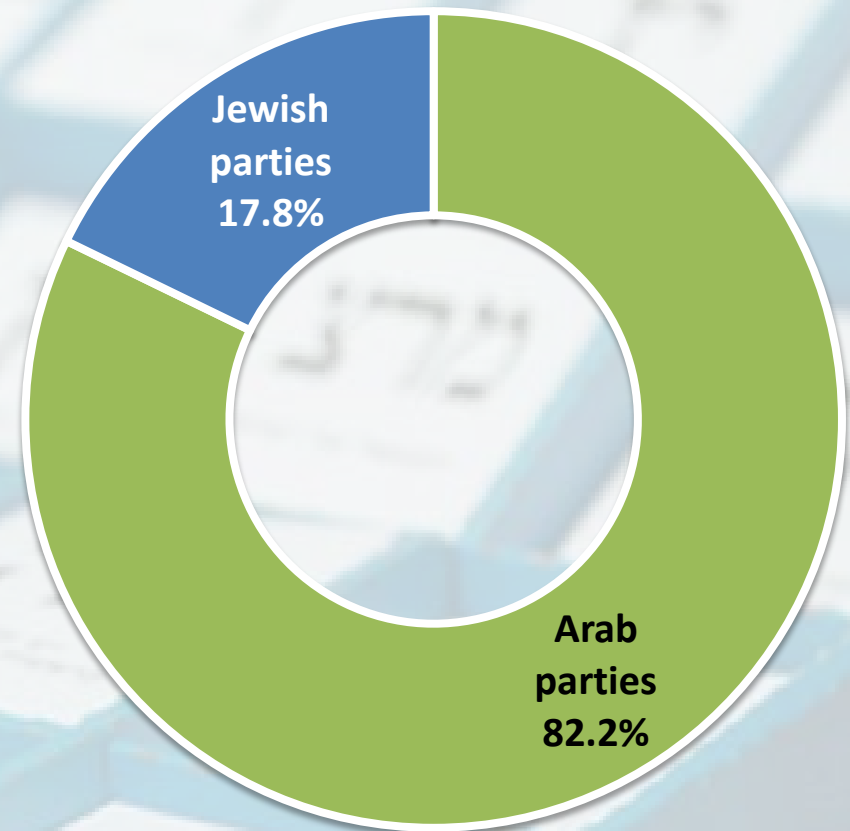

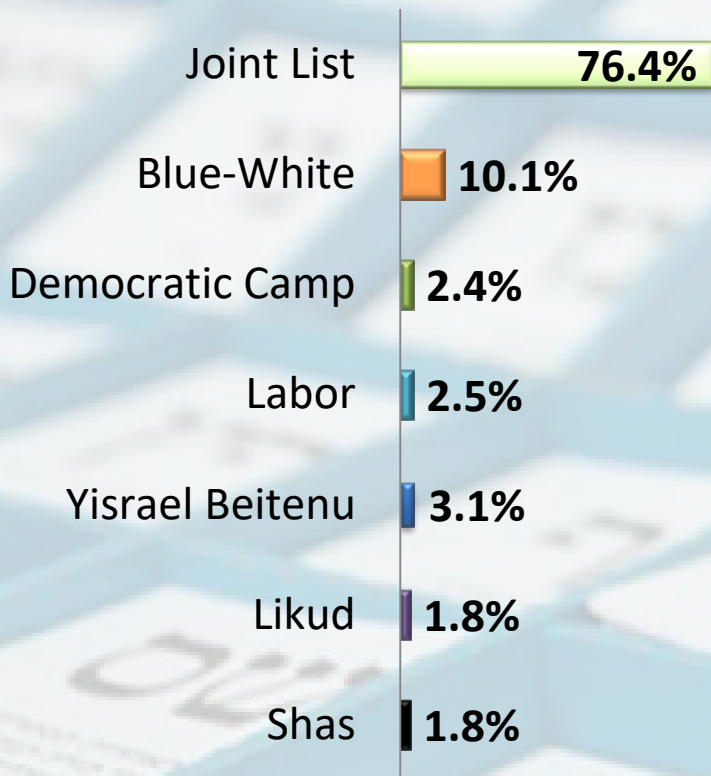

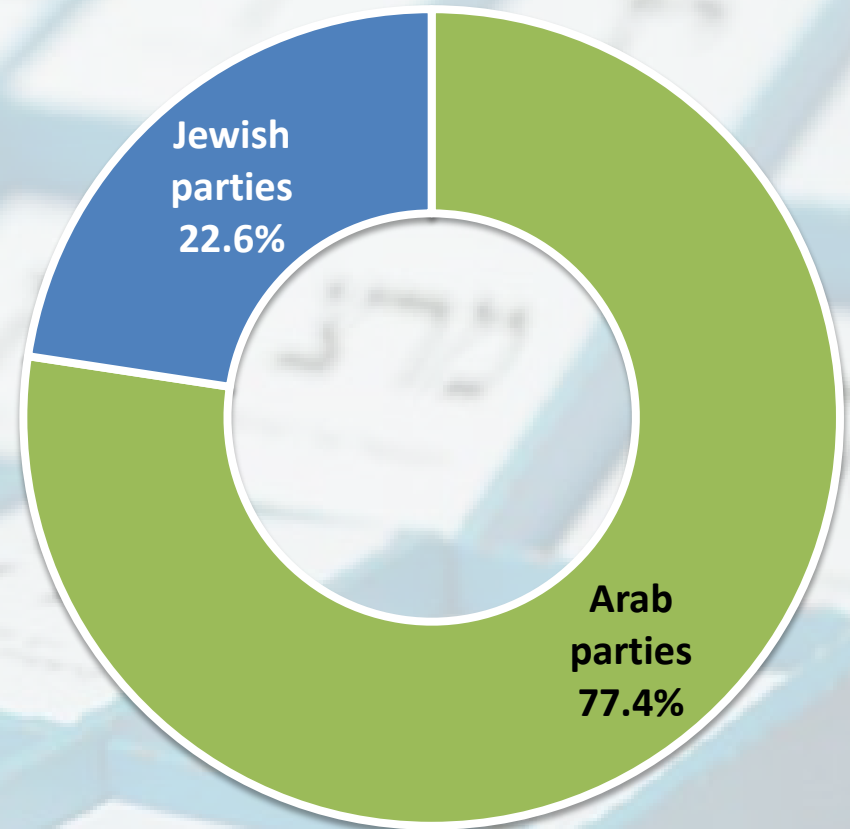

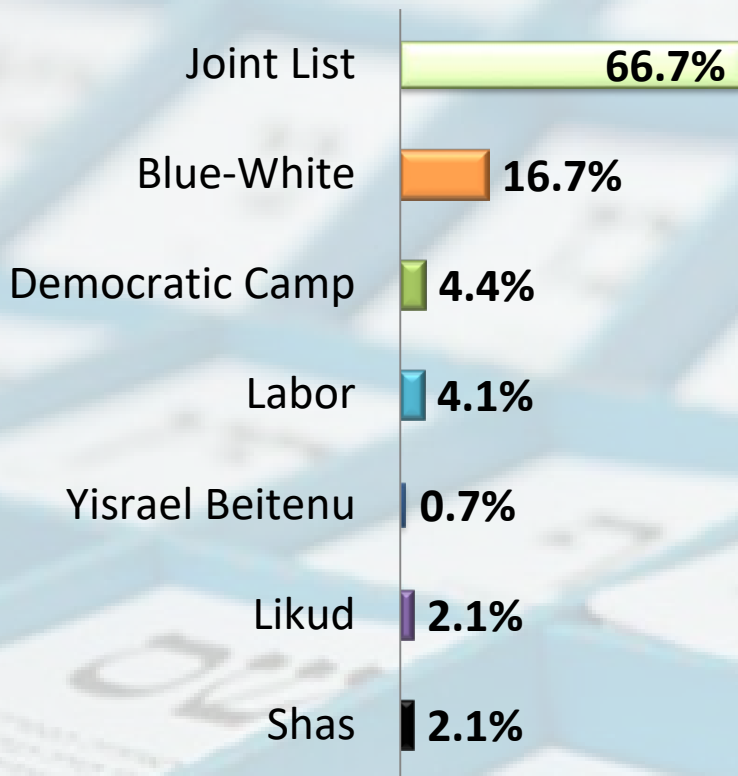

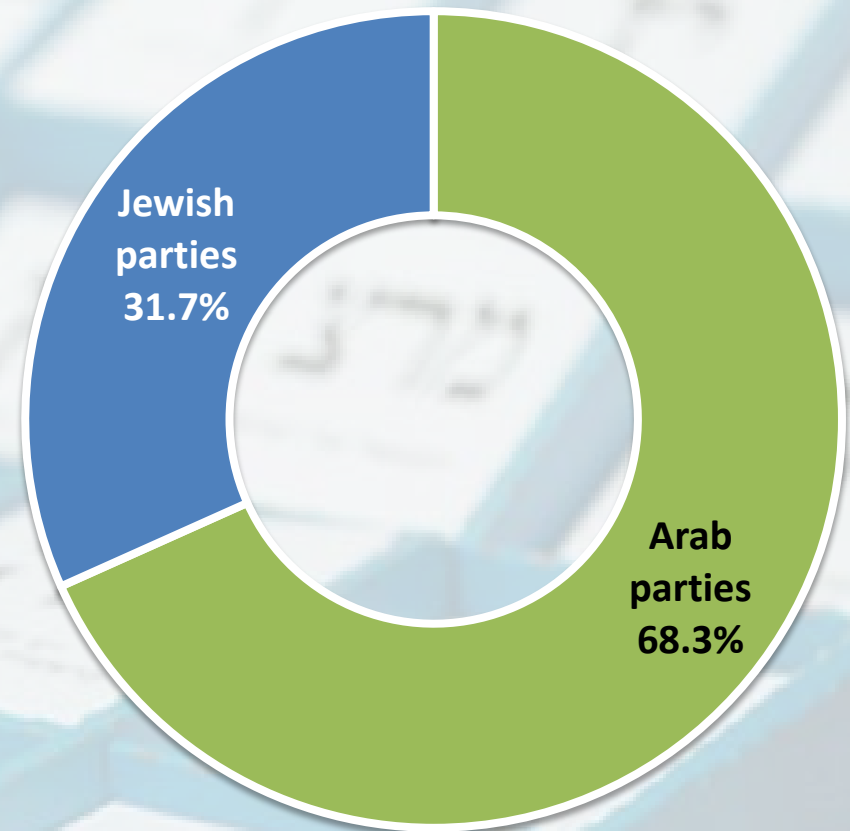

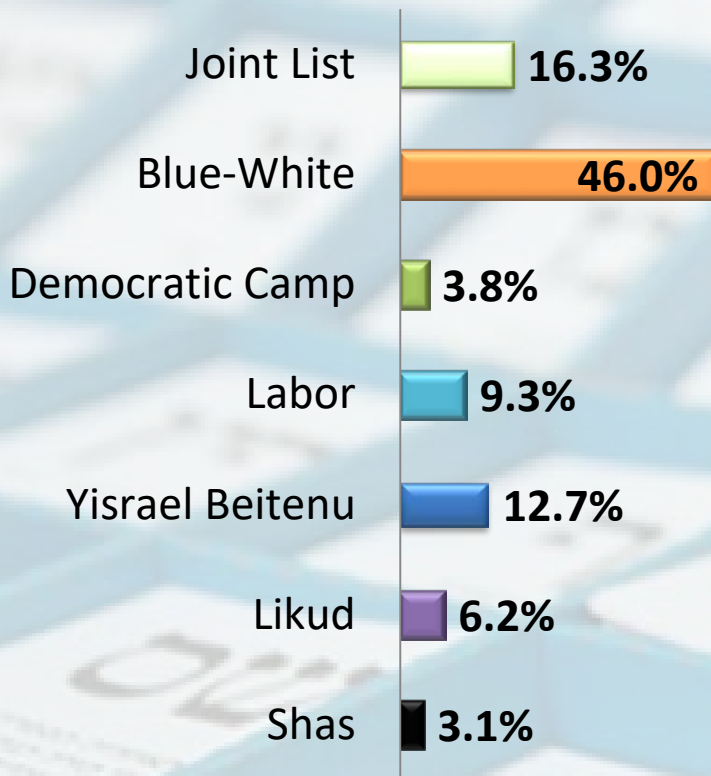

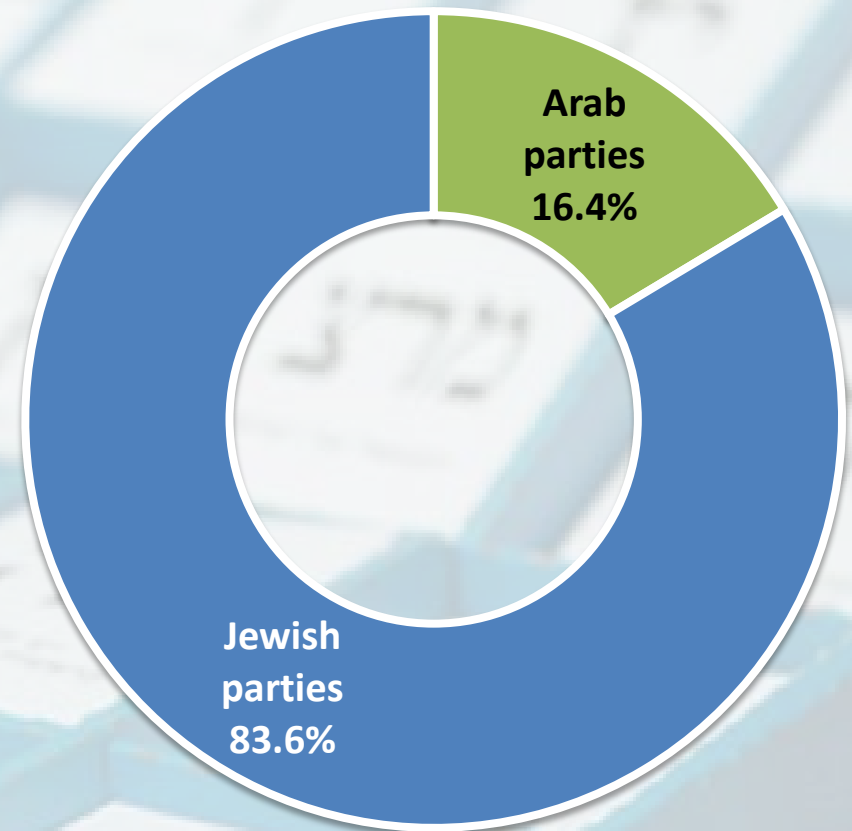

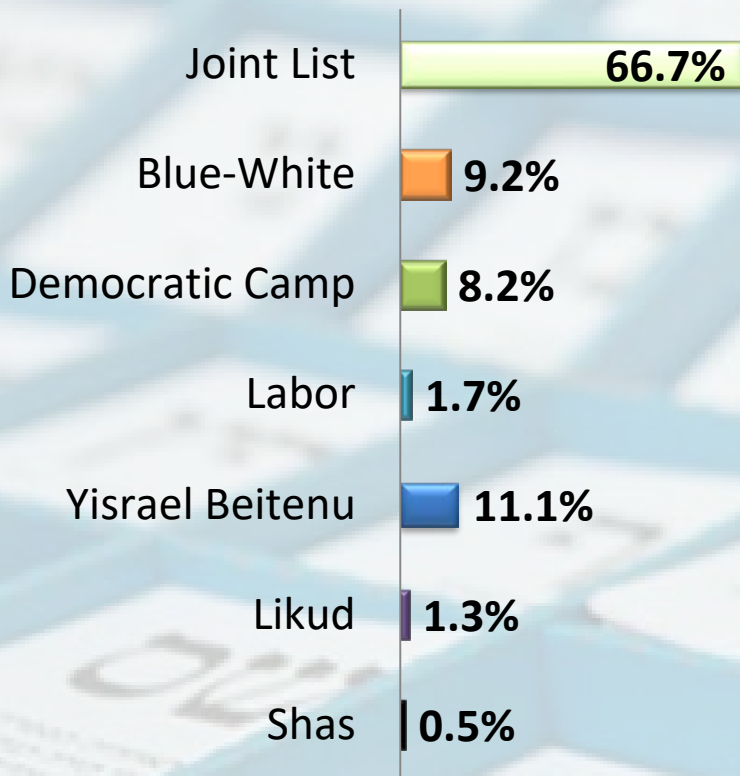

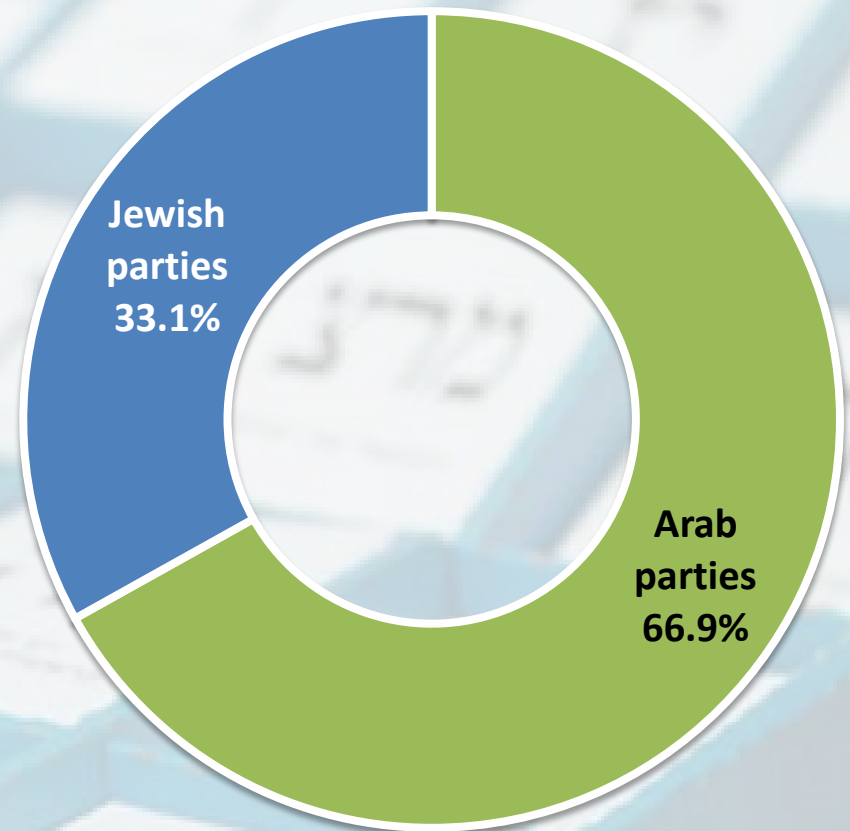

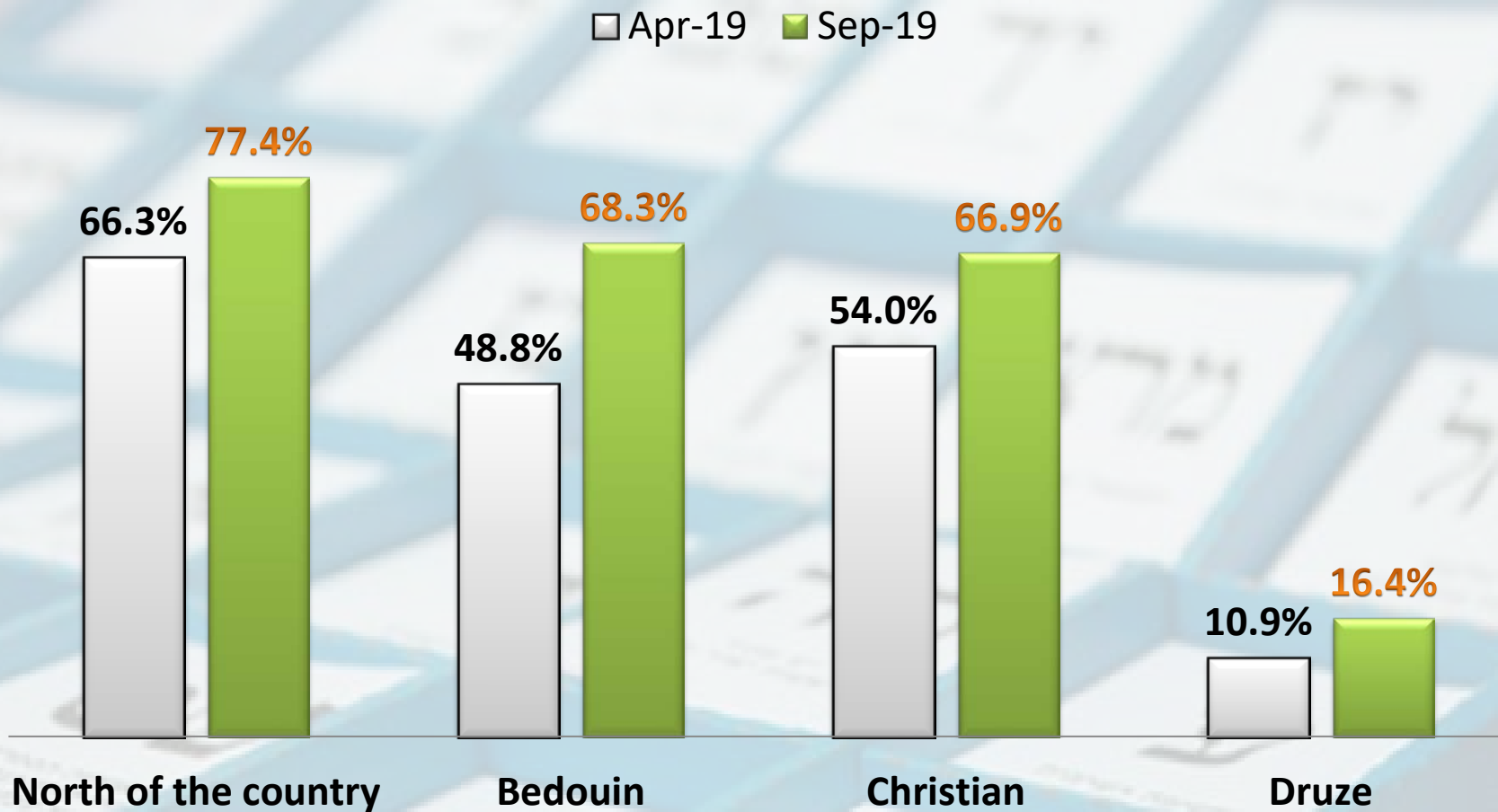

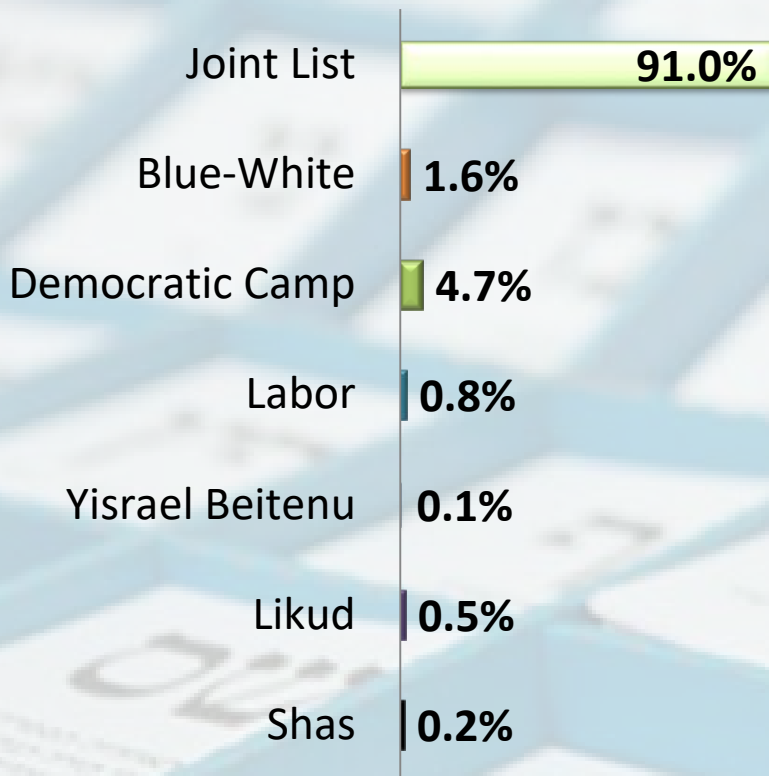

Support of Arab parties in the North of the country: April vs. September 2019

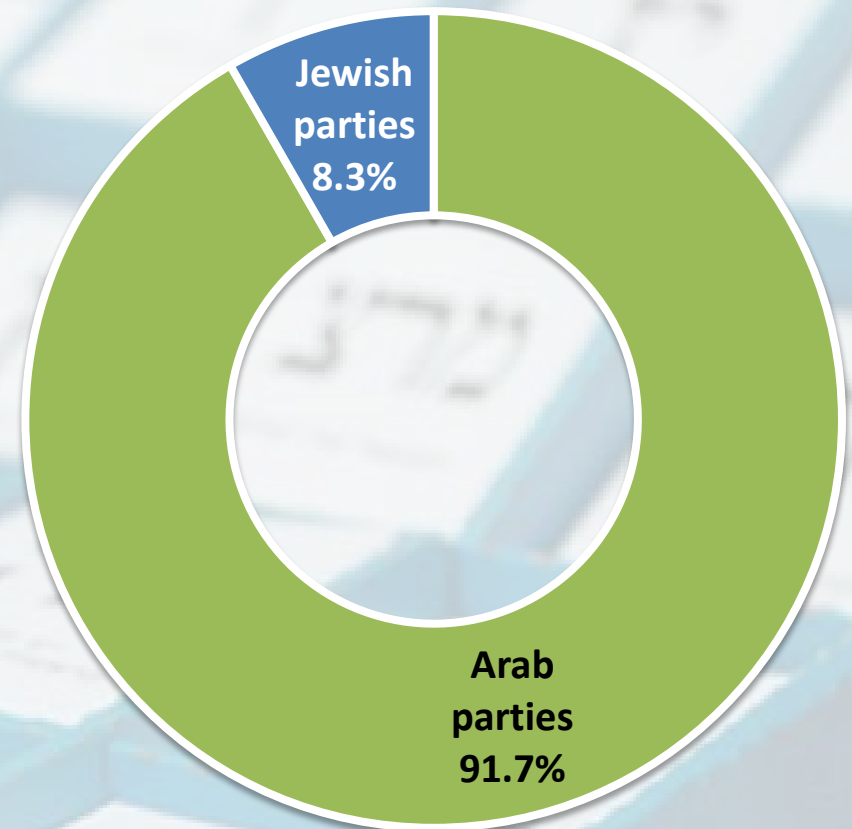


The Triangle region, turnout 60.5%

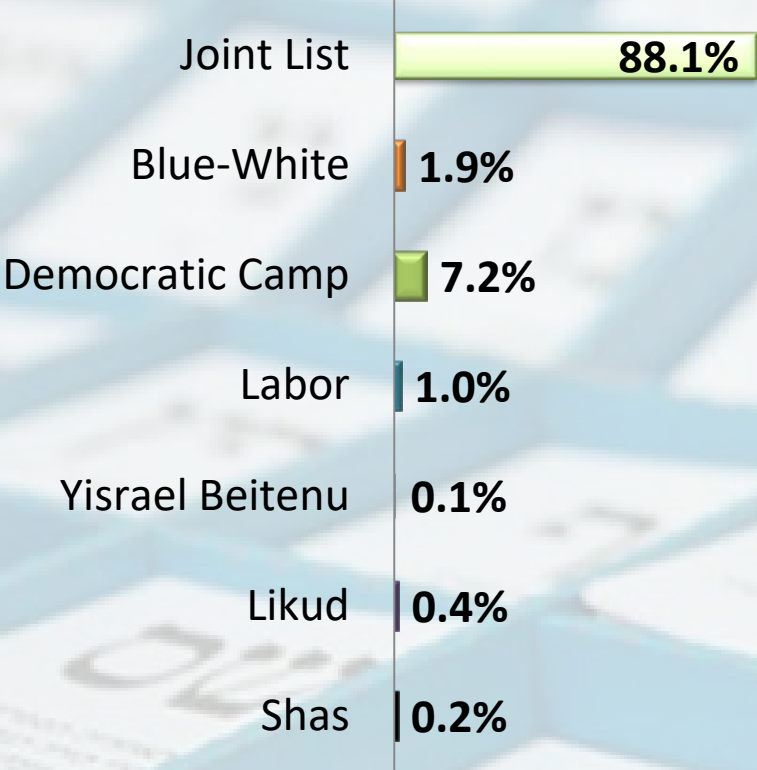

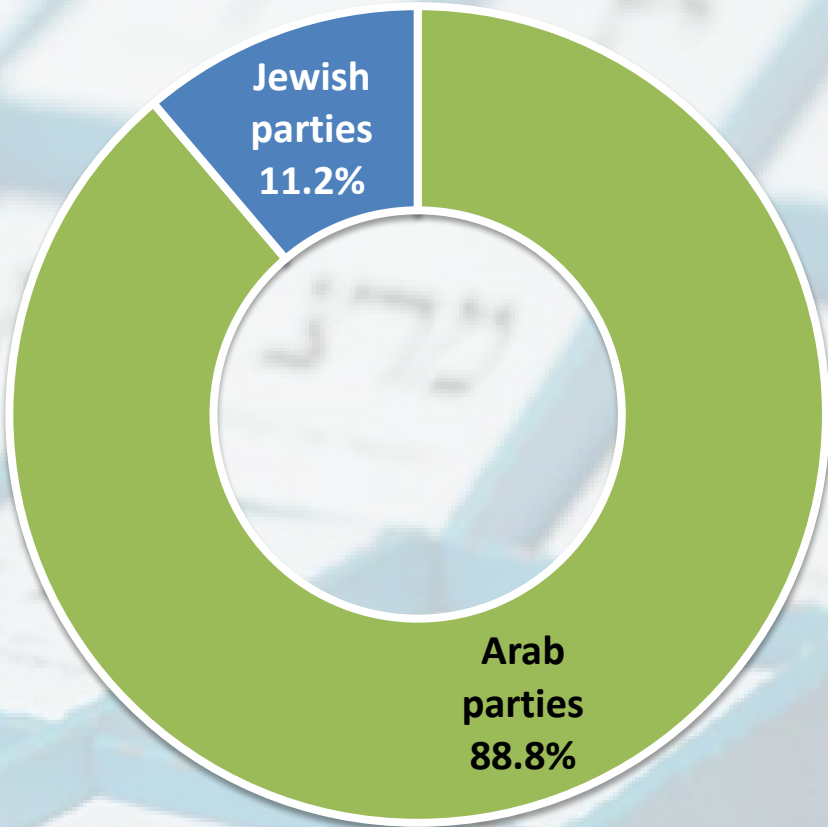

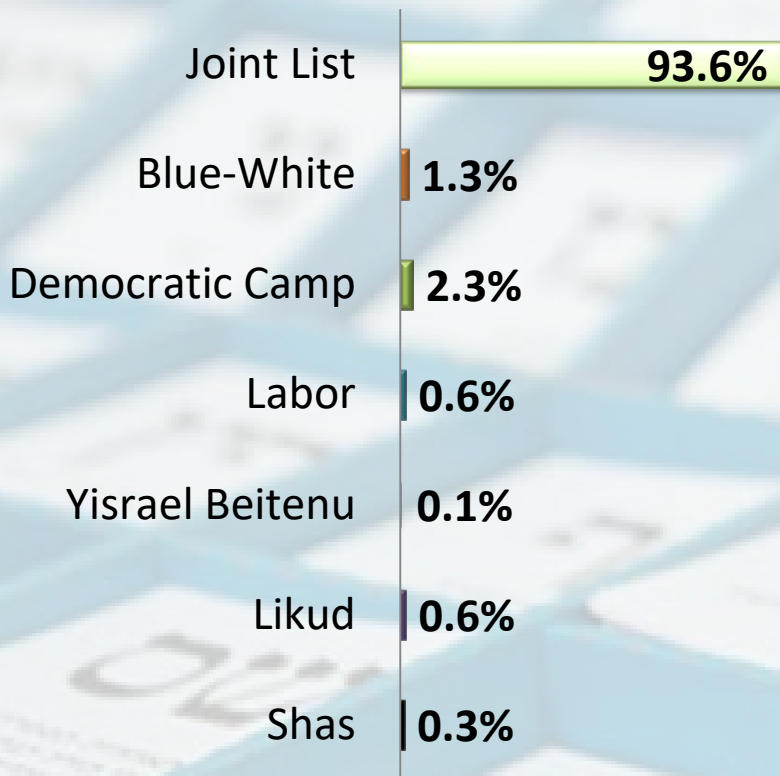

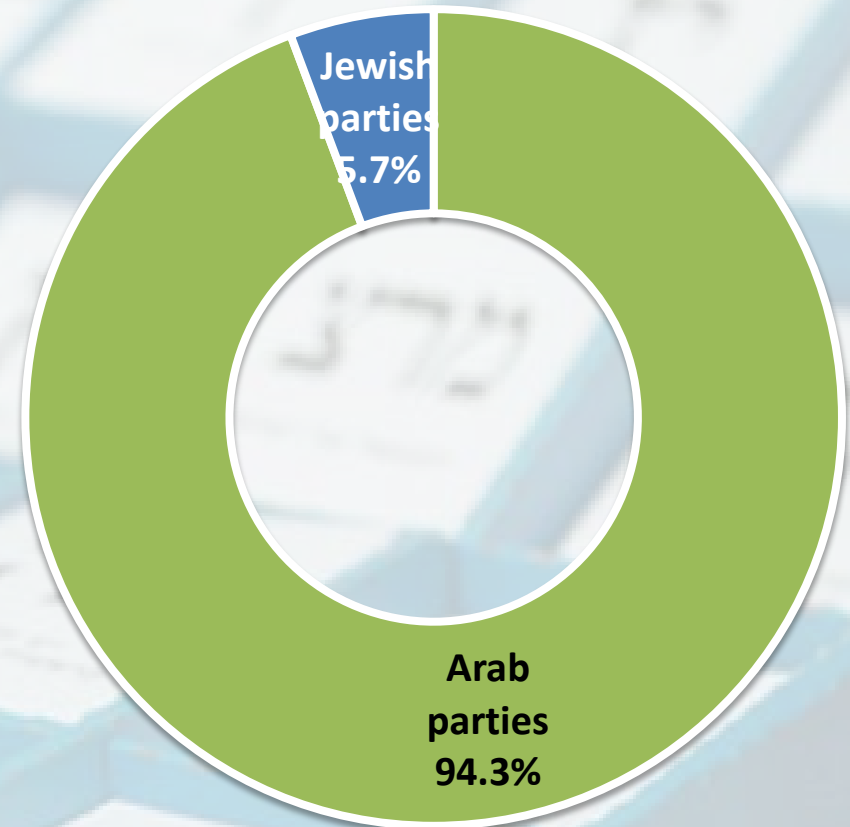

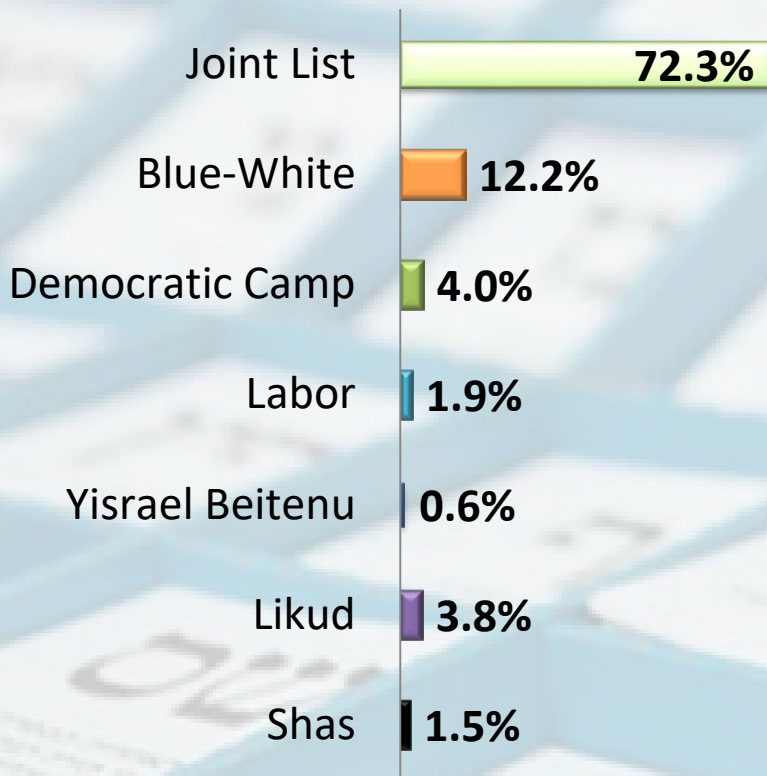

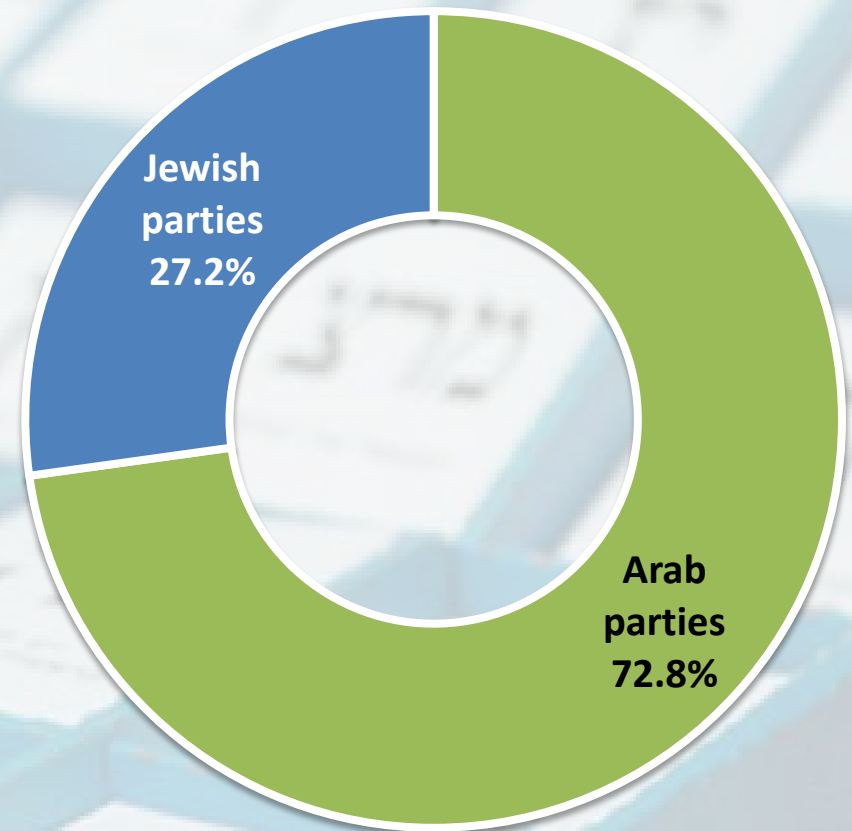

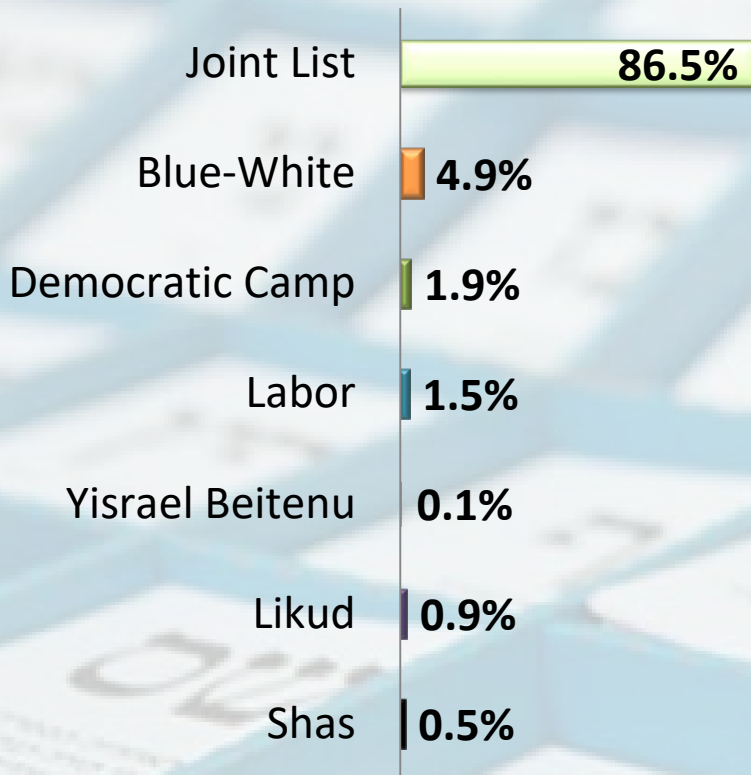

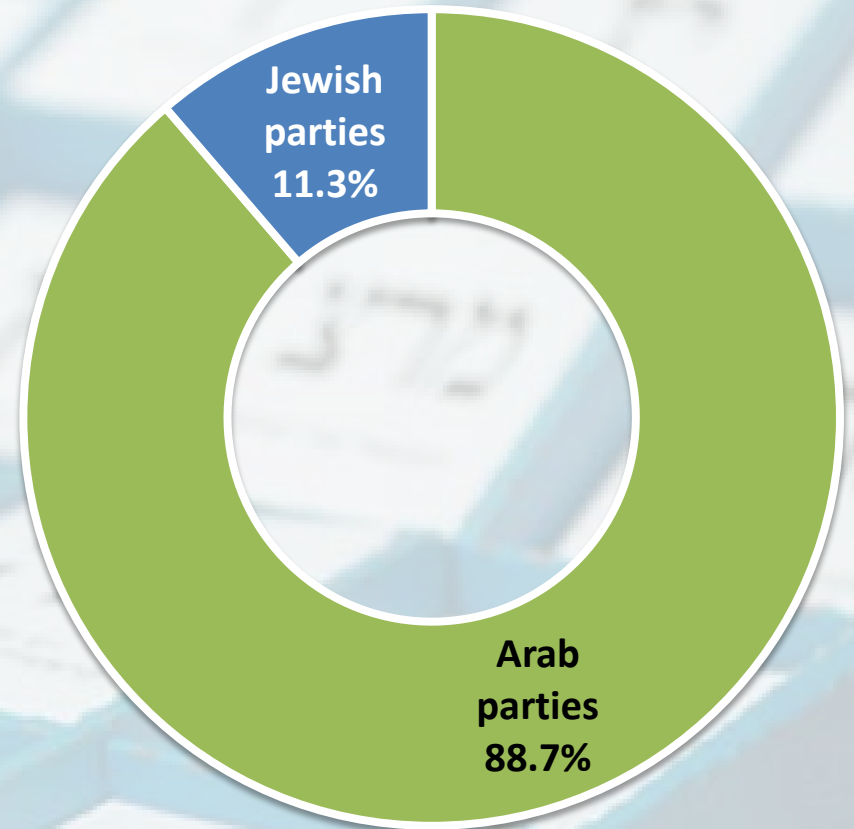

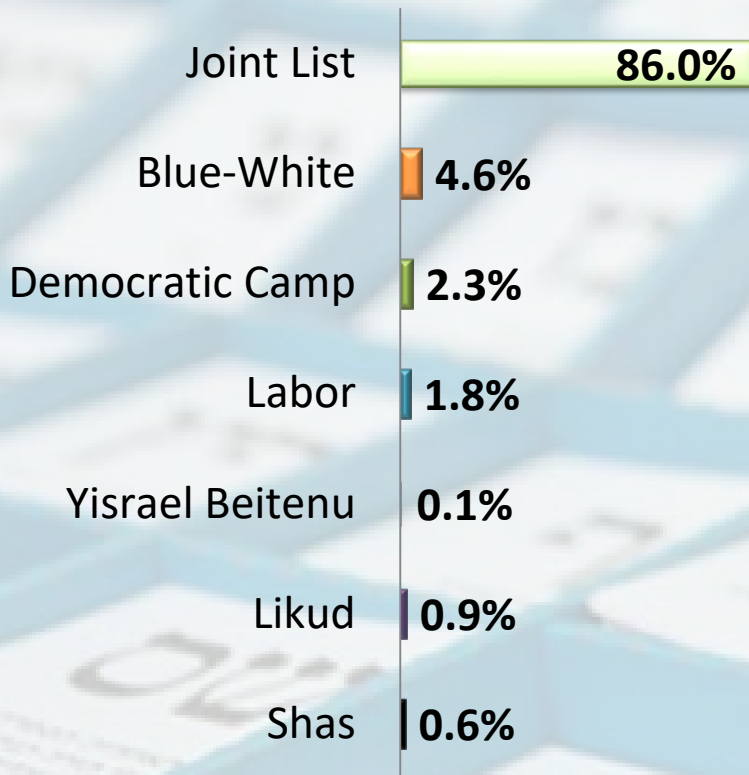

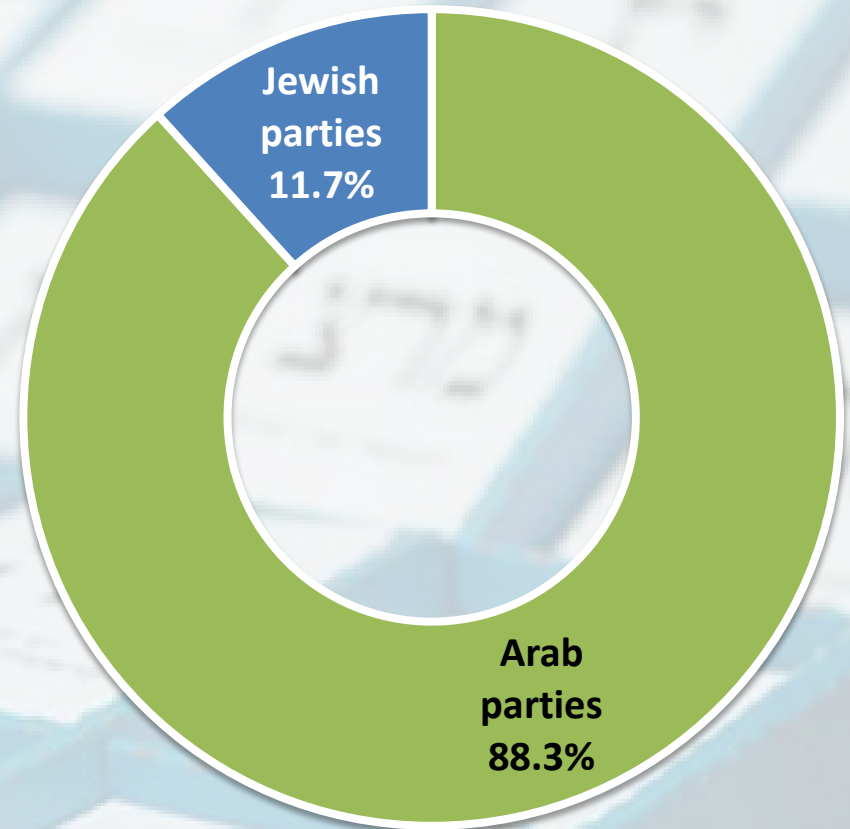

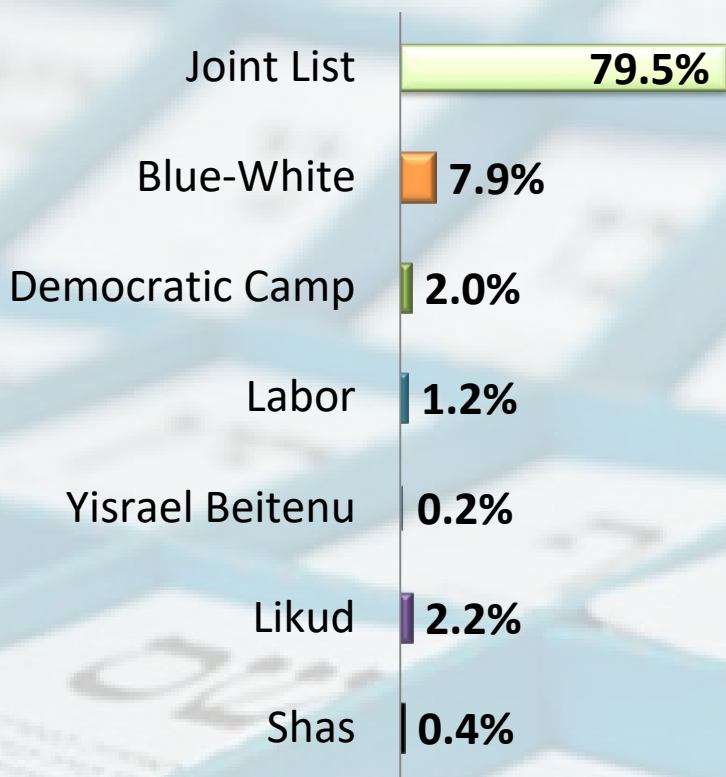

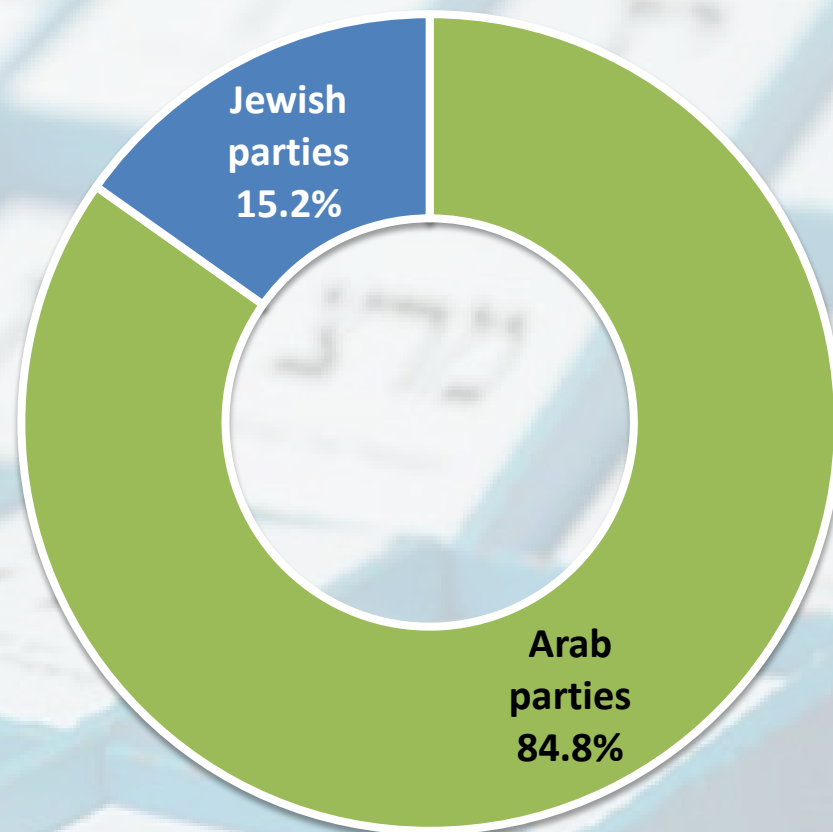

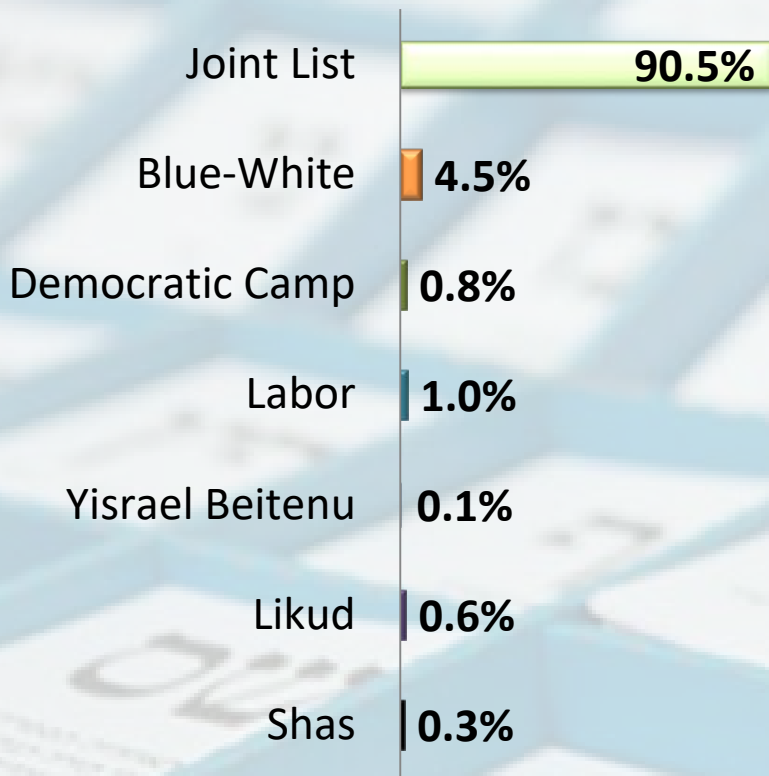

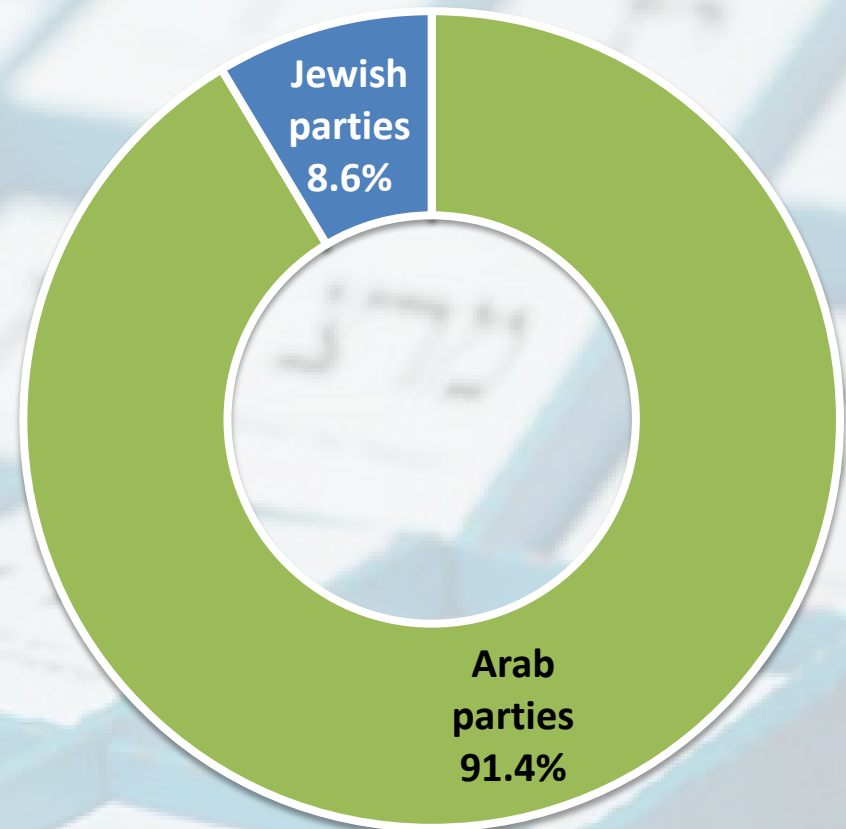

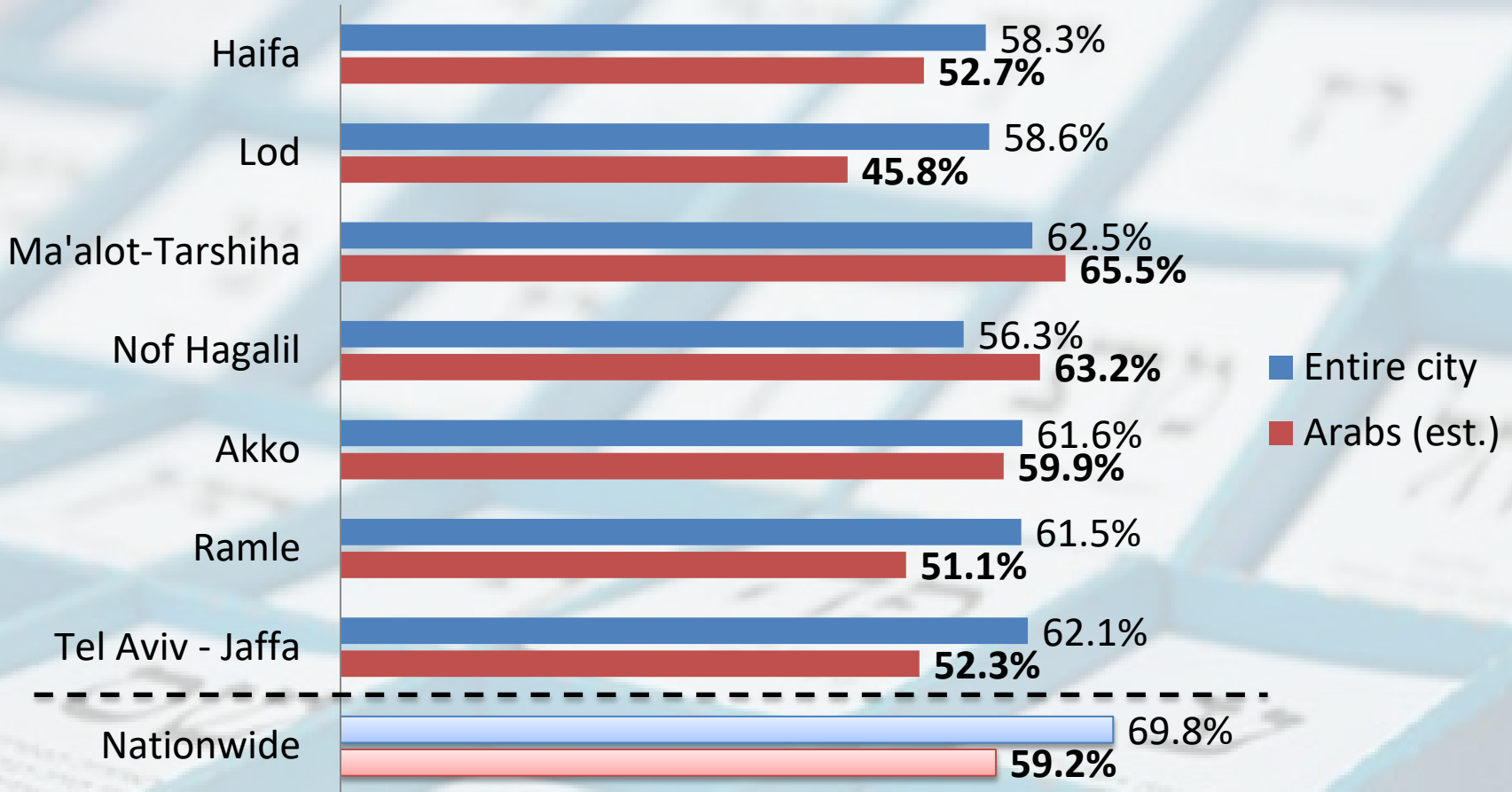

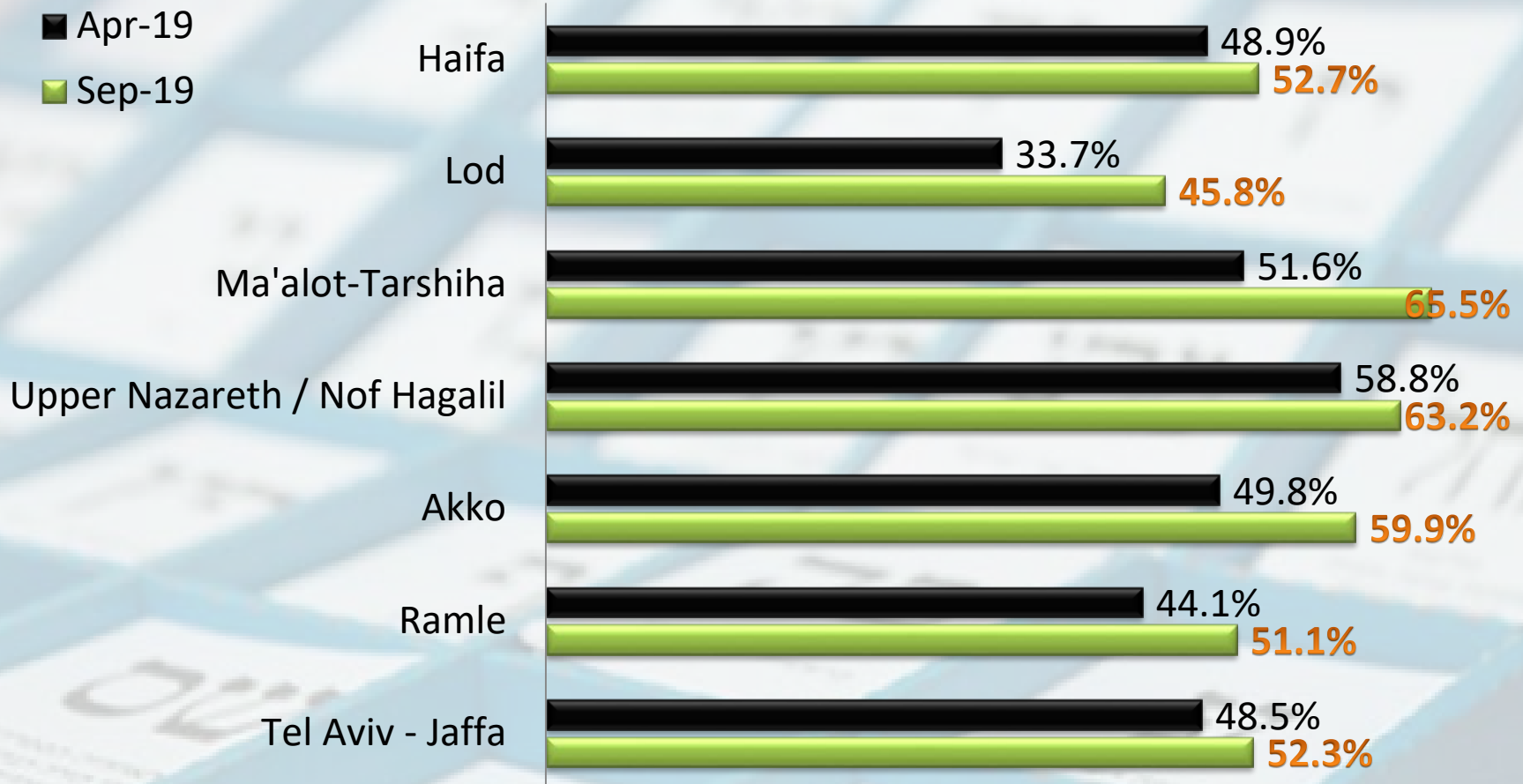

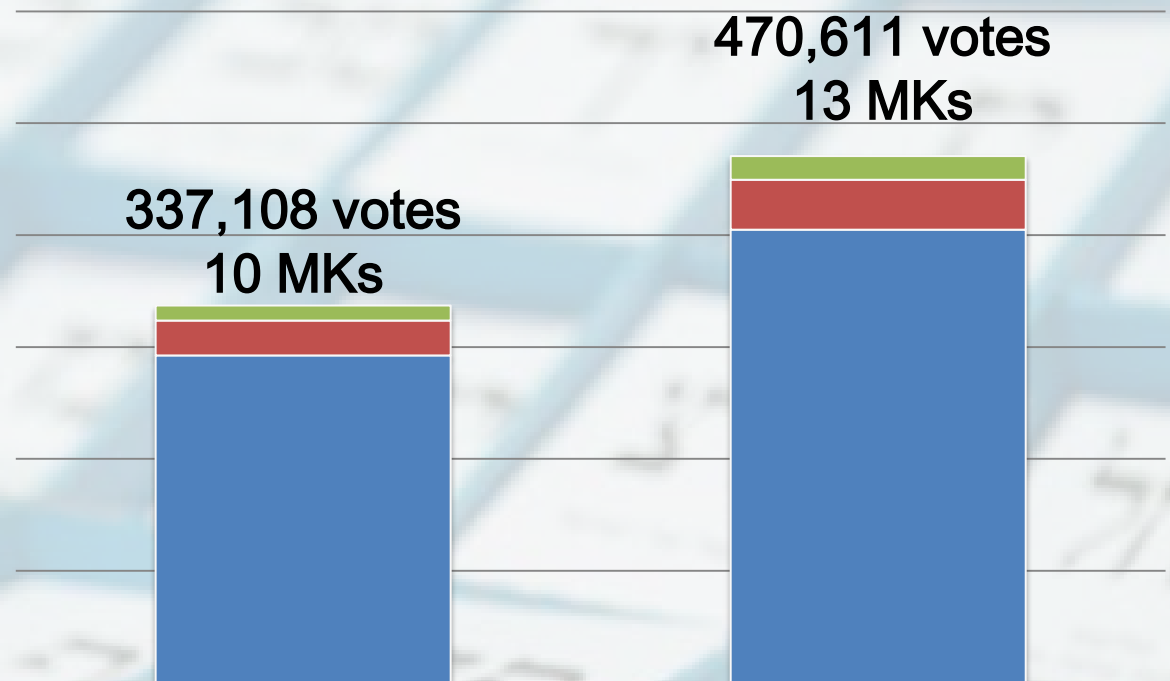
Turnout of Arab residents in mixed Jewish-Arab cities

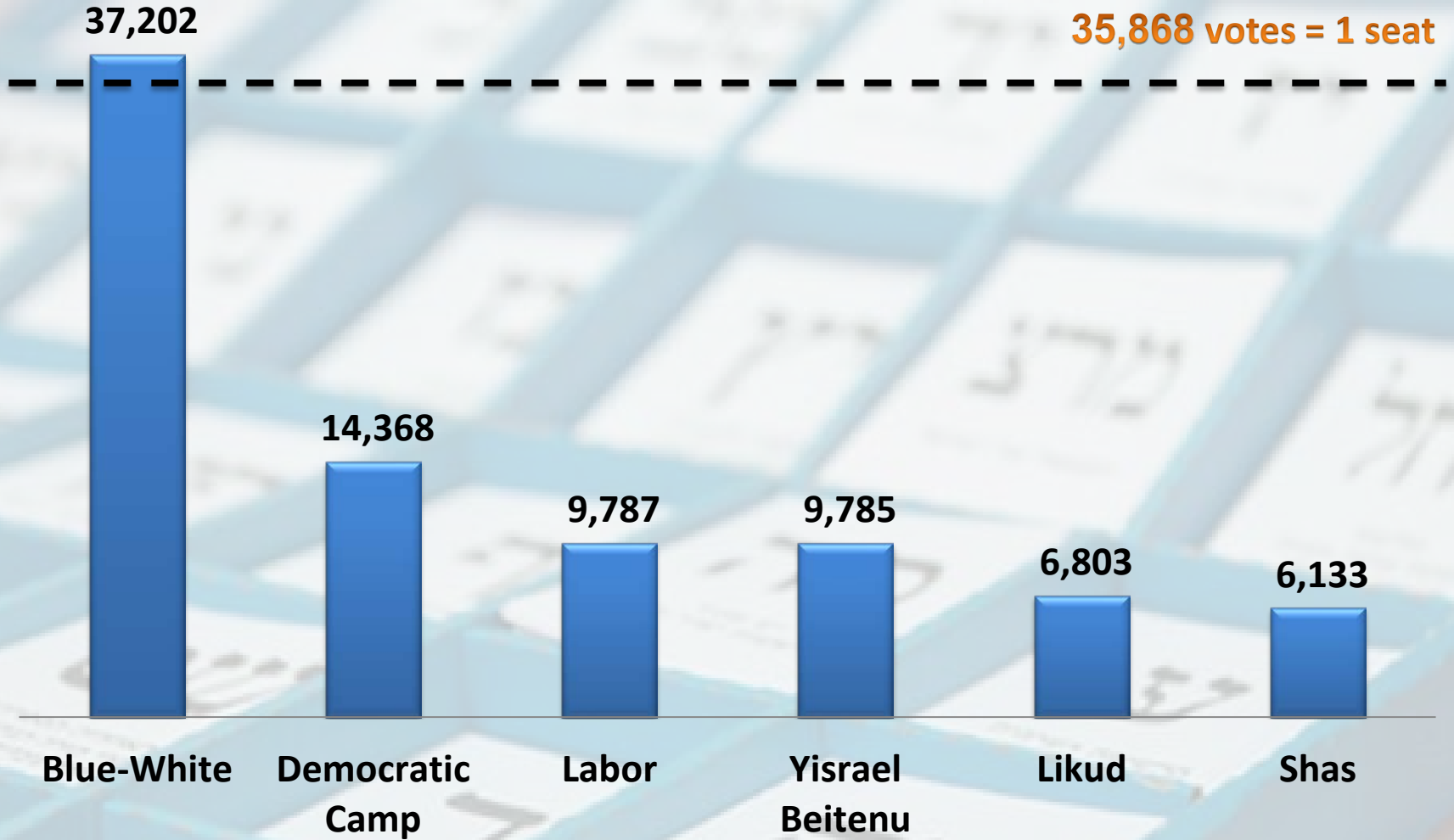
