



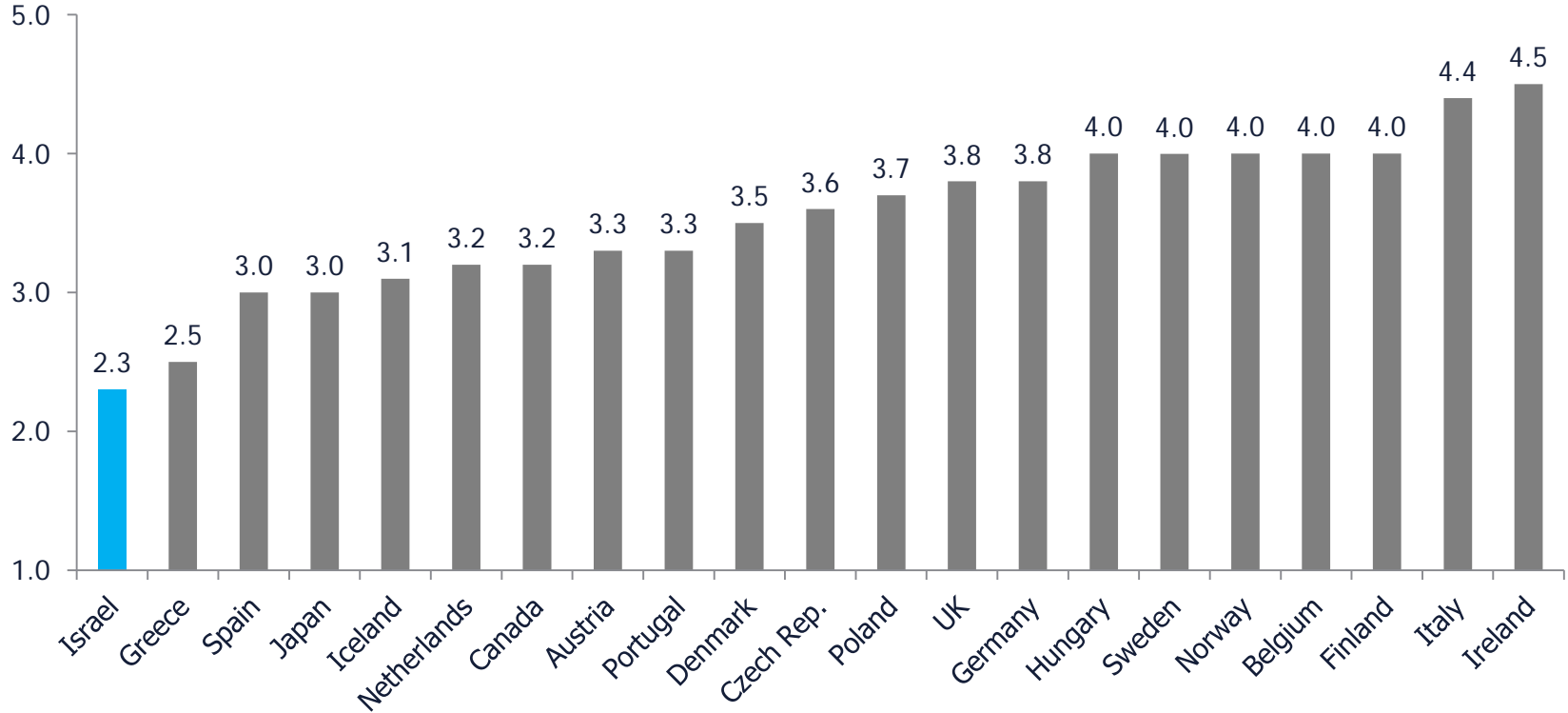

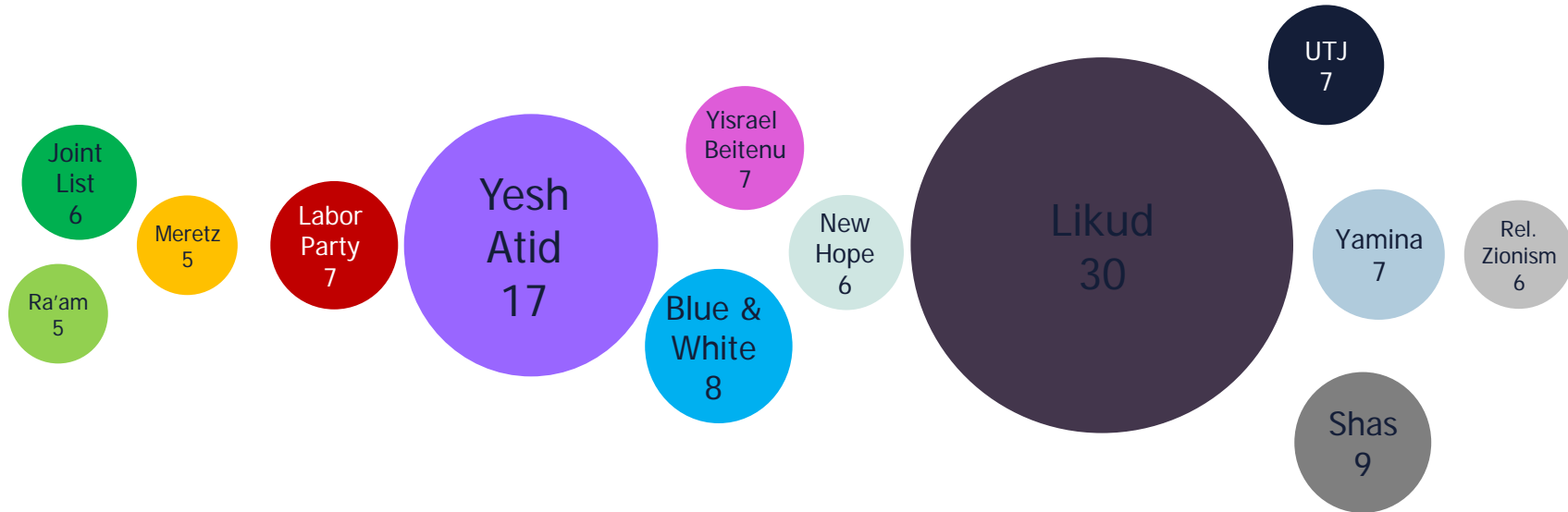

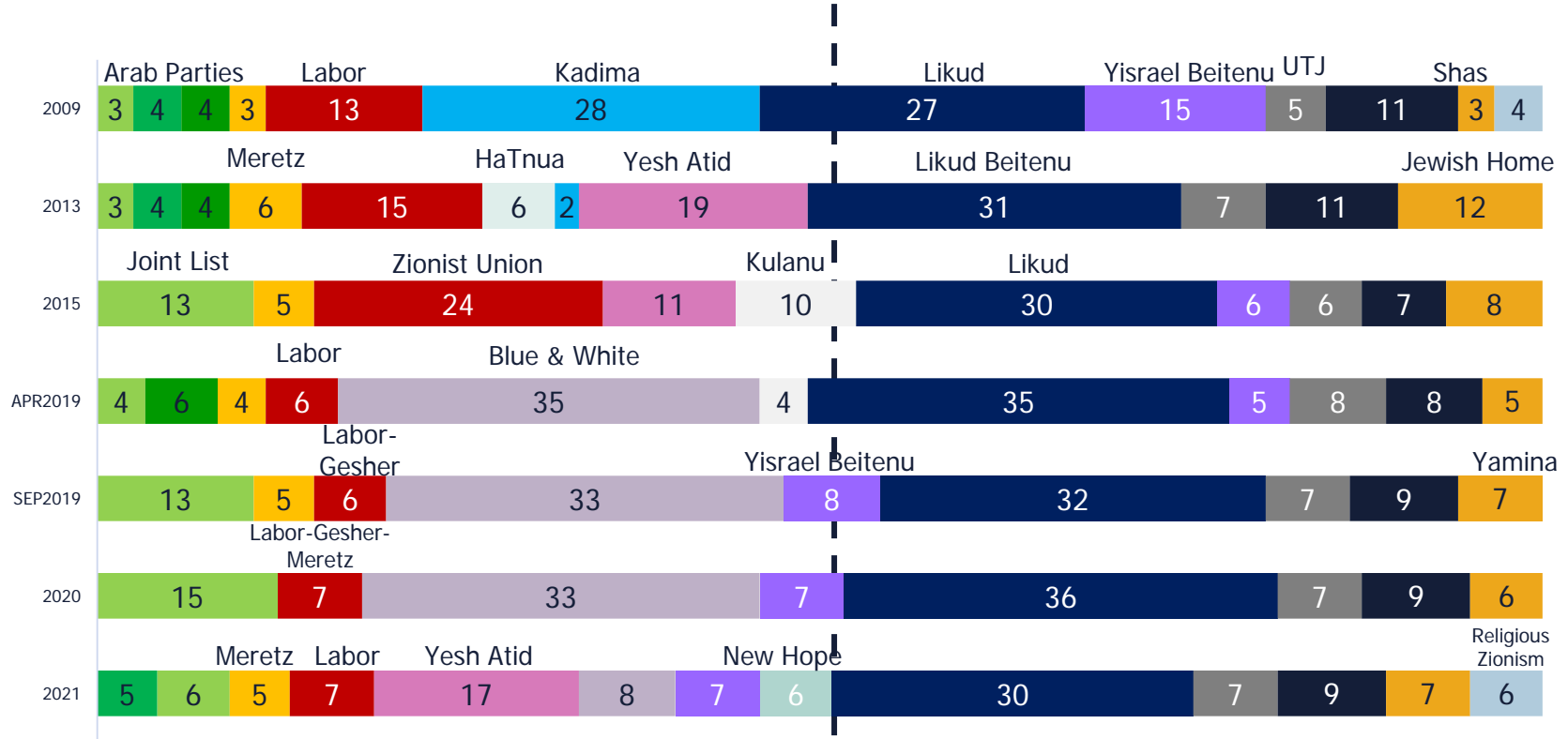
Frequency of Elections, in years averages since 1996



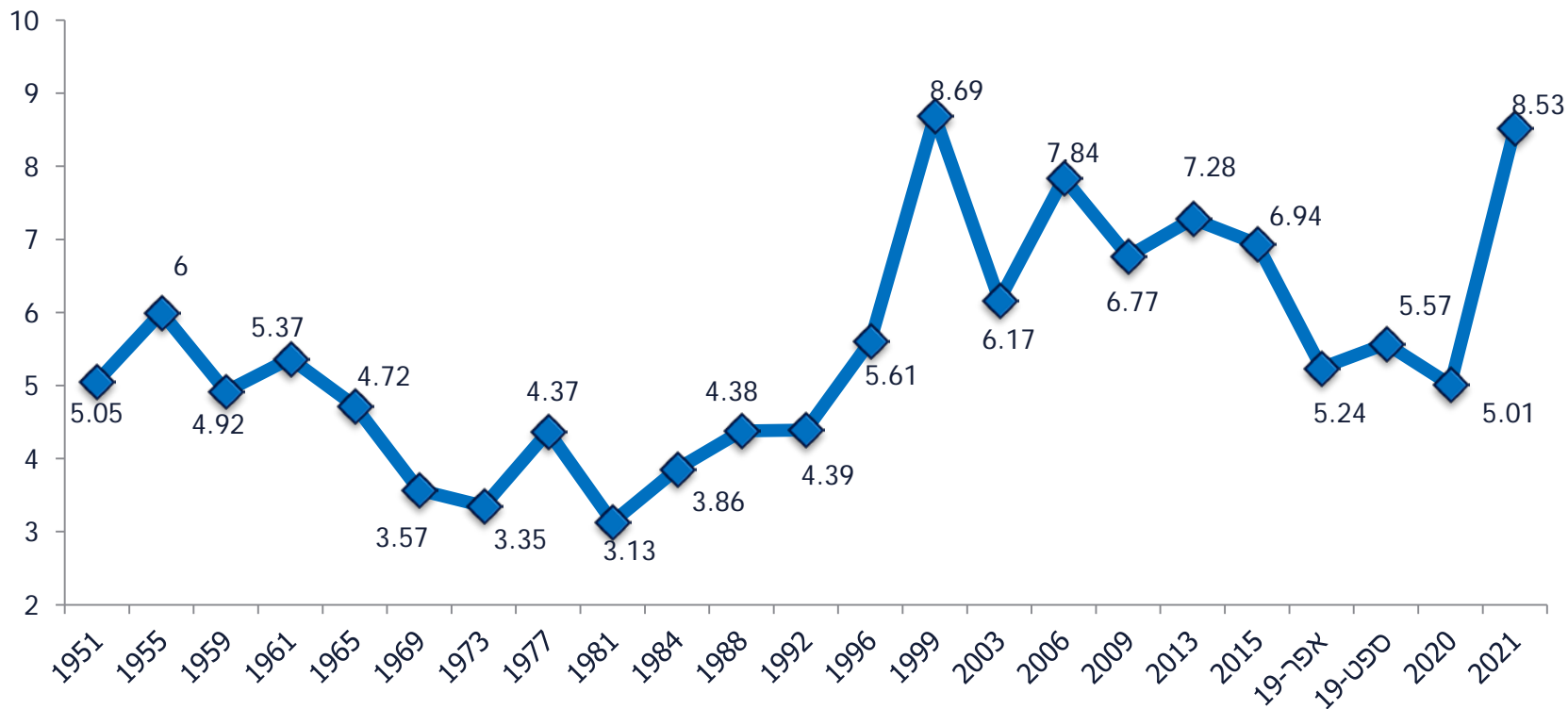
The Party Map Following the 2021 Elections



Evolution of the Party System 2009-2021

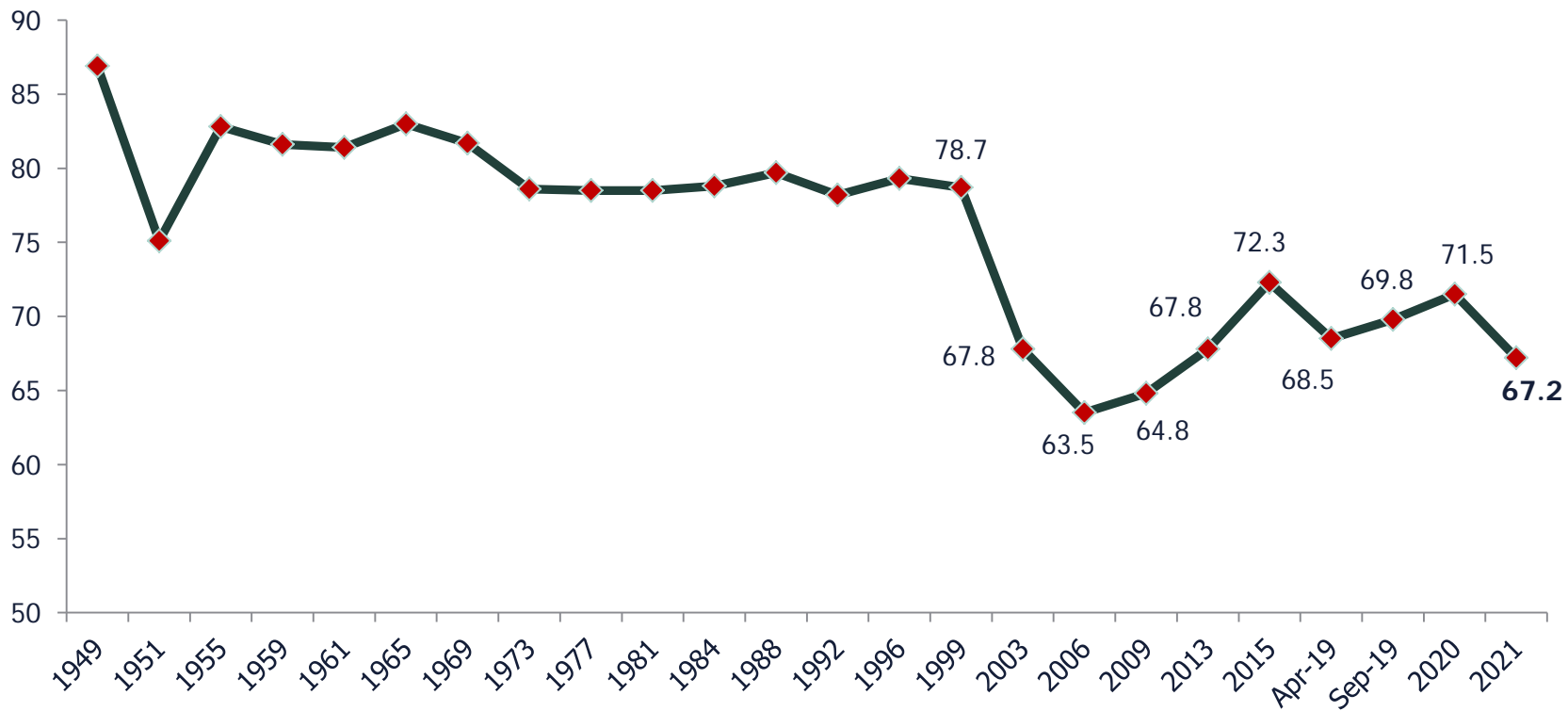


Fragmentation: the Effective Number of Parties



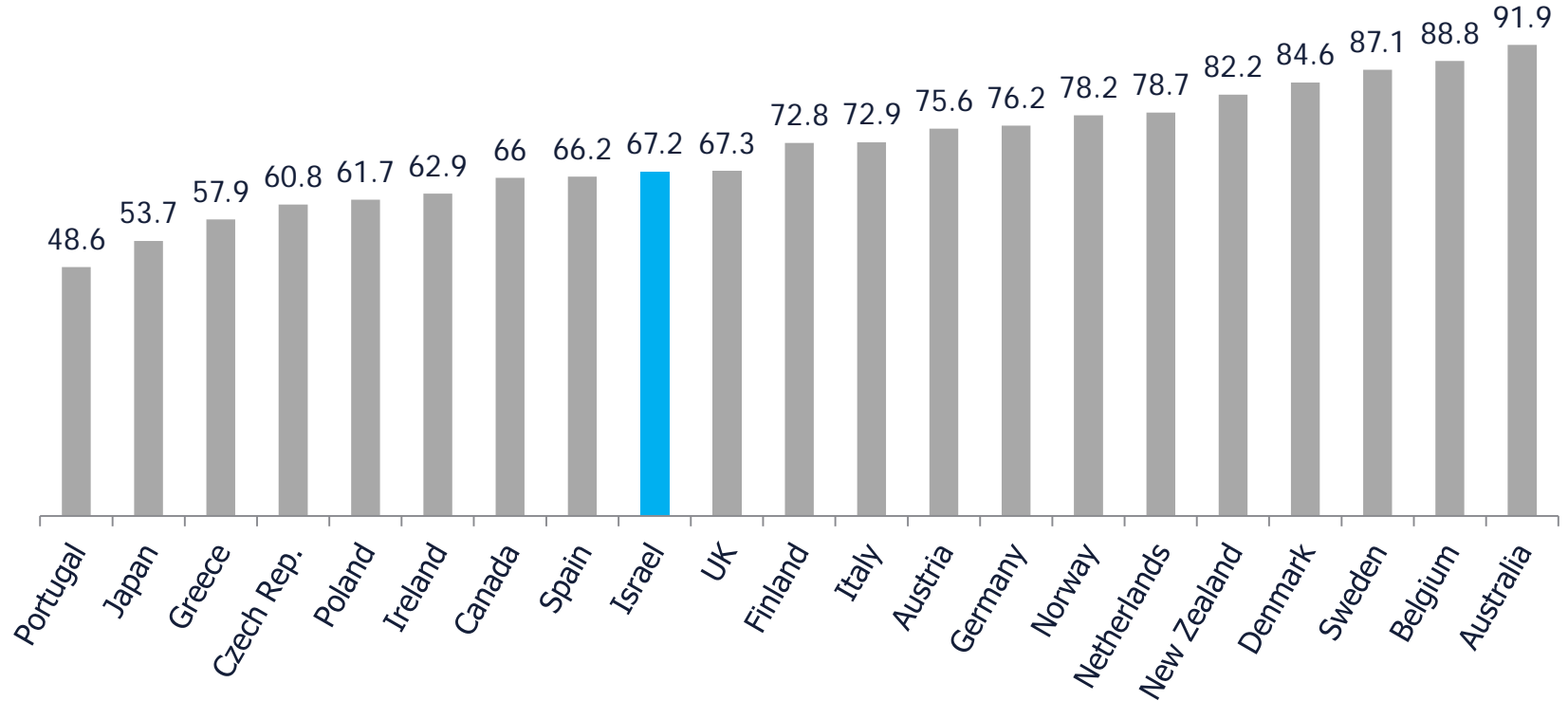
The effective number of parties is an index that reflects the fragmentation level in parliament. It takes into account not only the number of parties but also their proportional size.

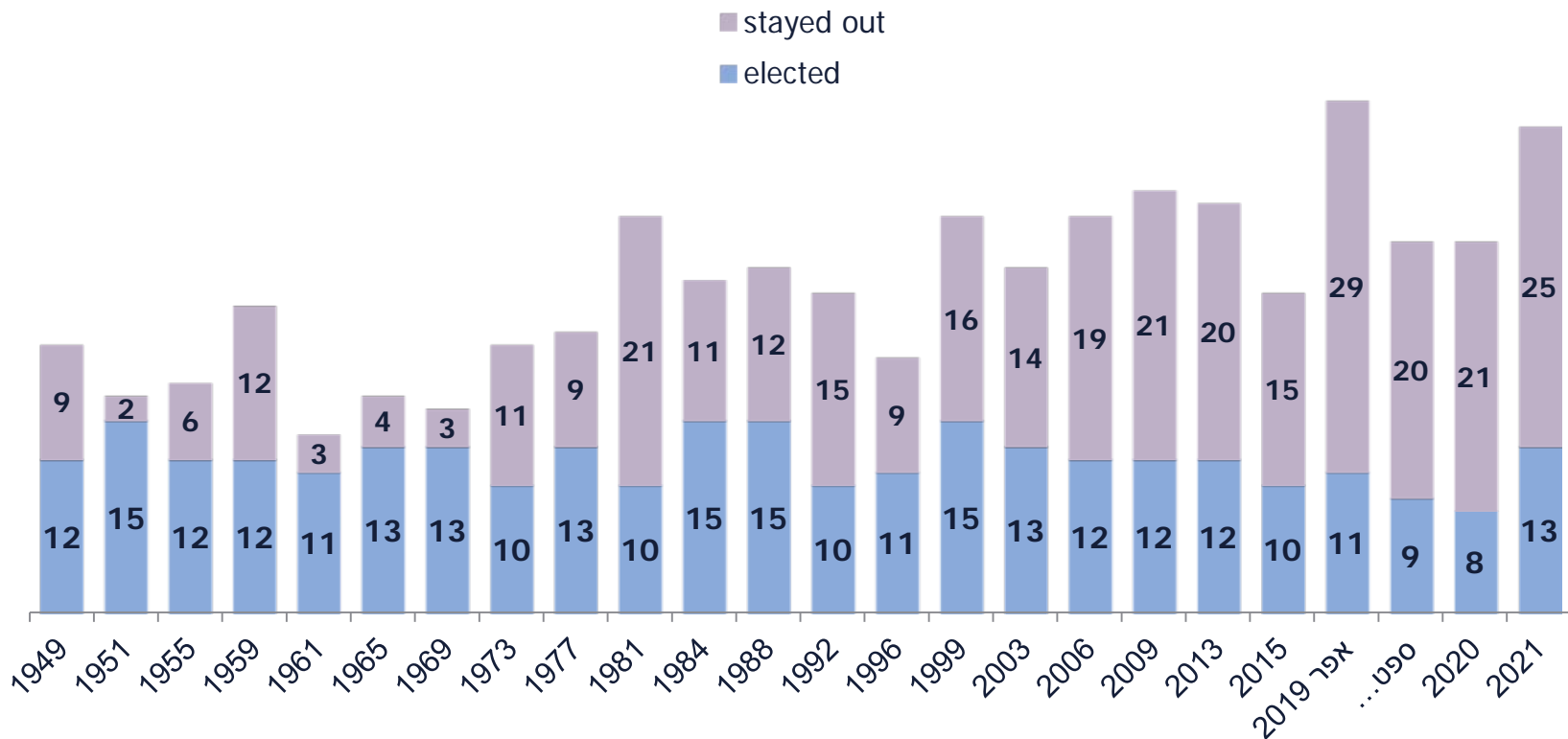


Turnout: Israel Compared to Other Democracies

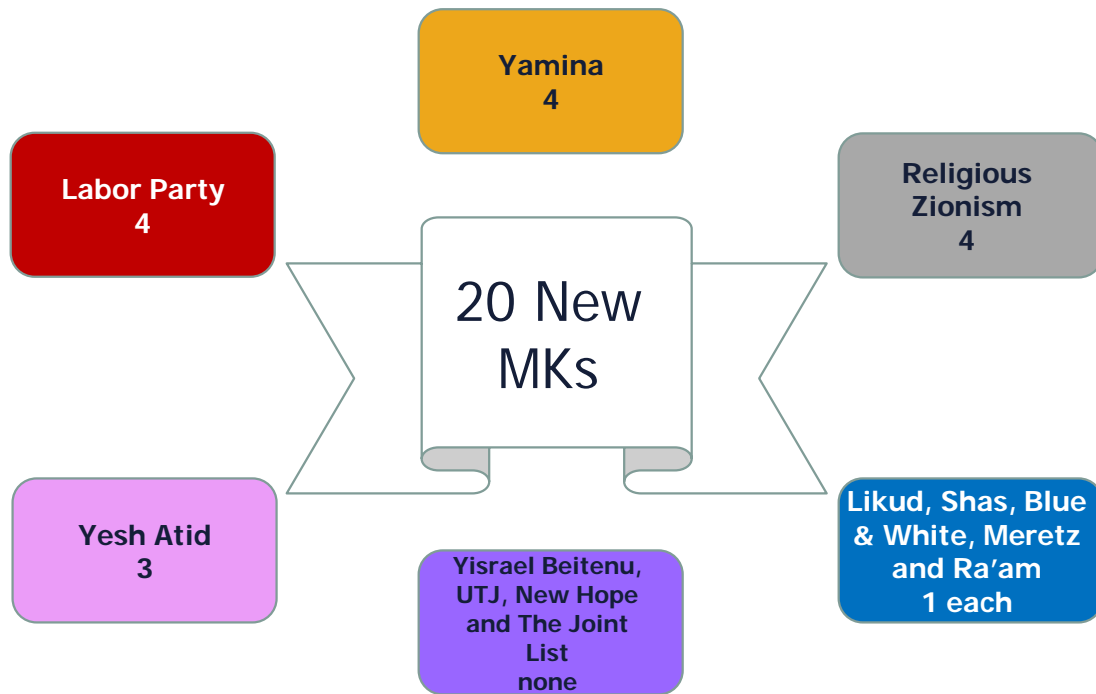

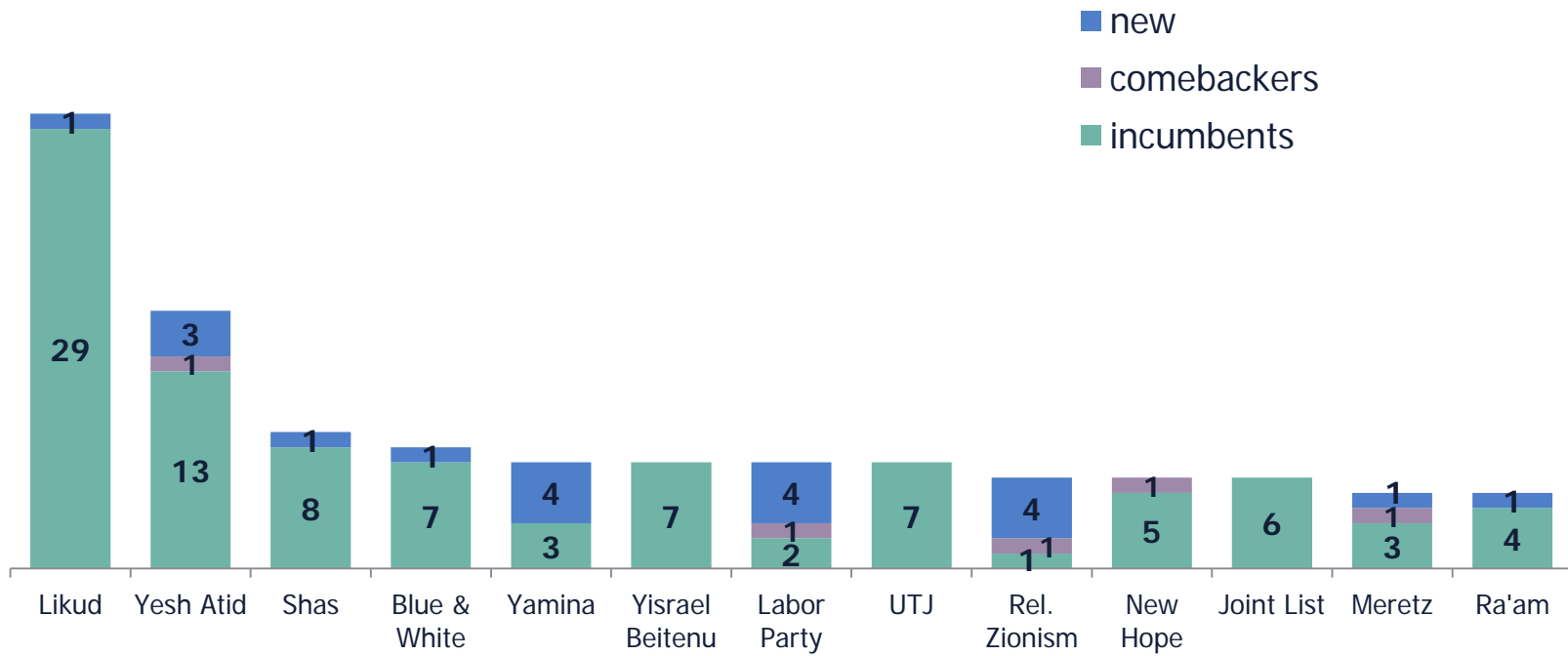

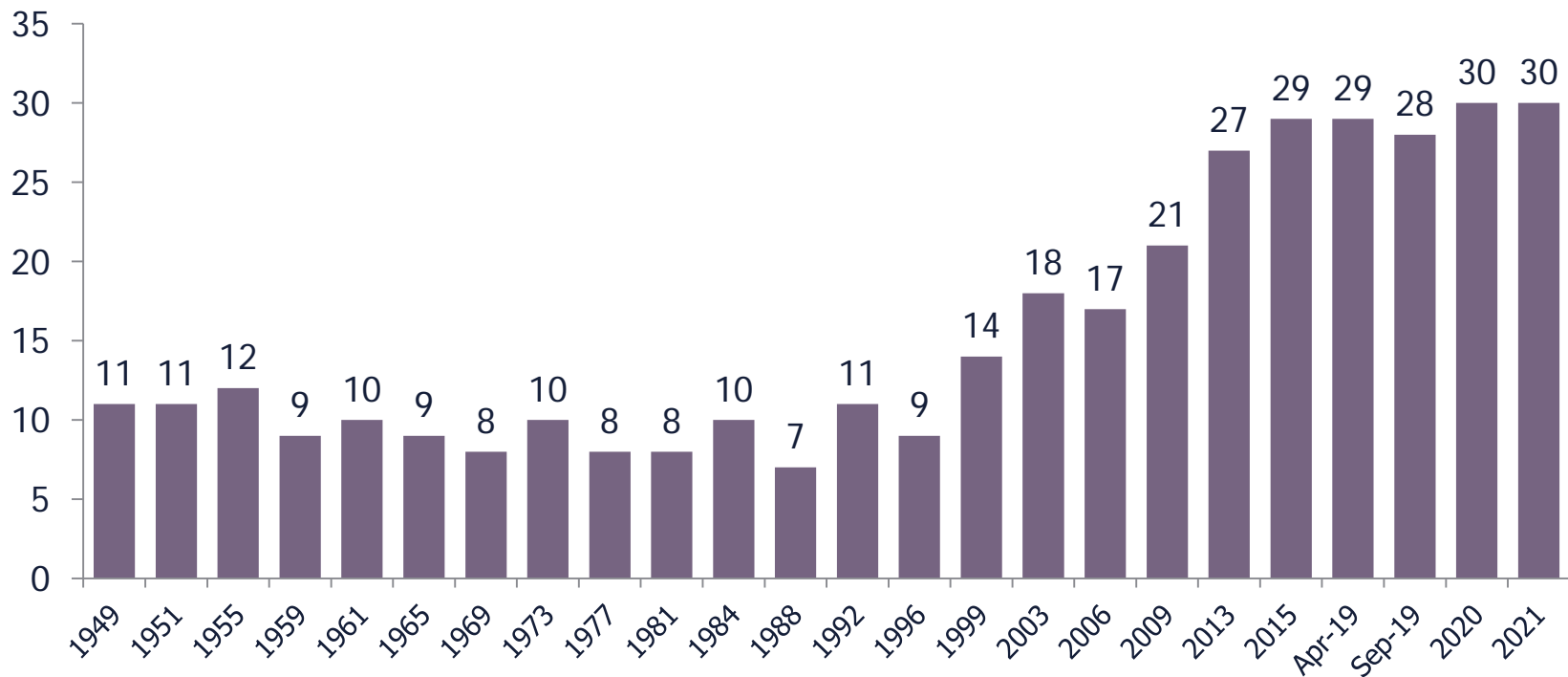

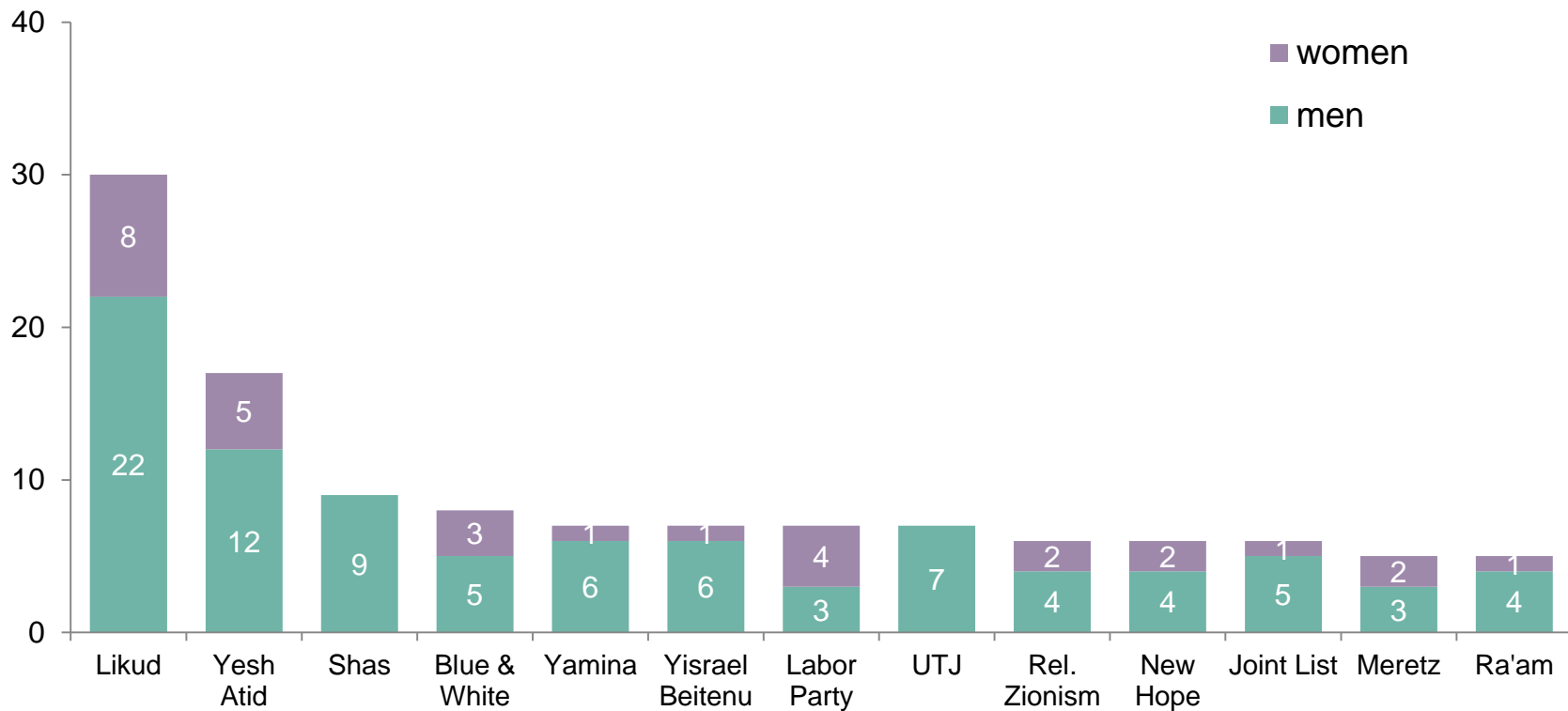
Incumbent, Newcomers and “Returnees”



Women MKs



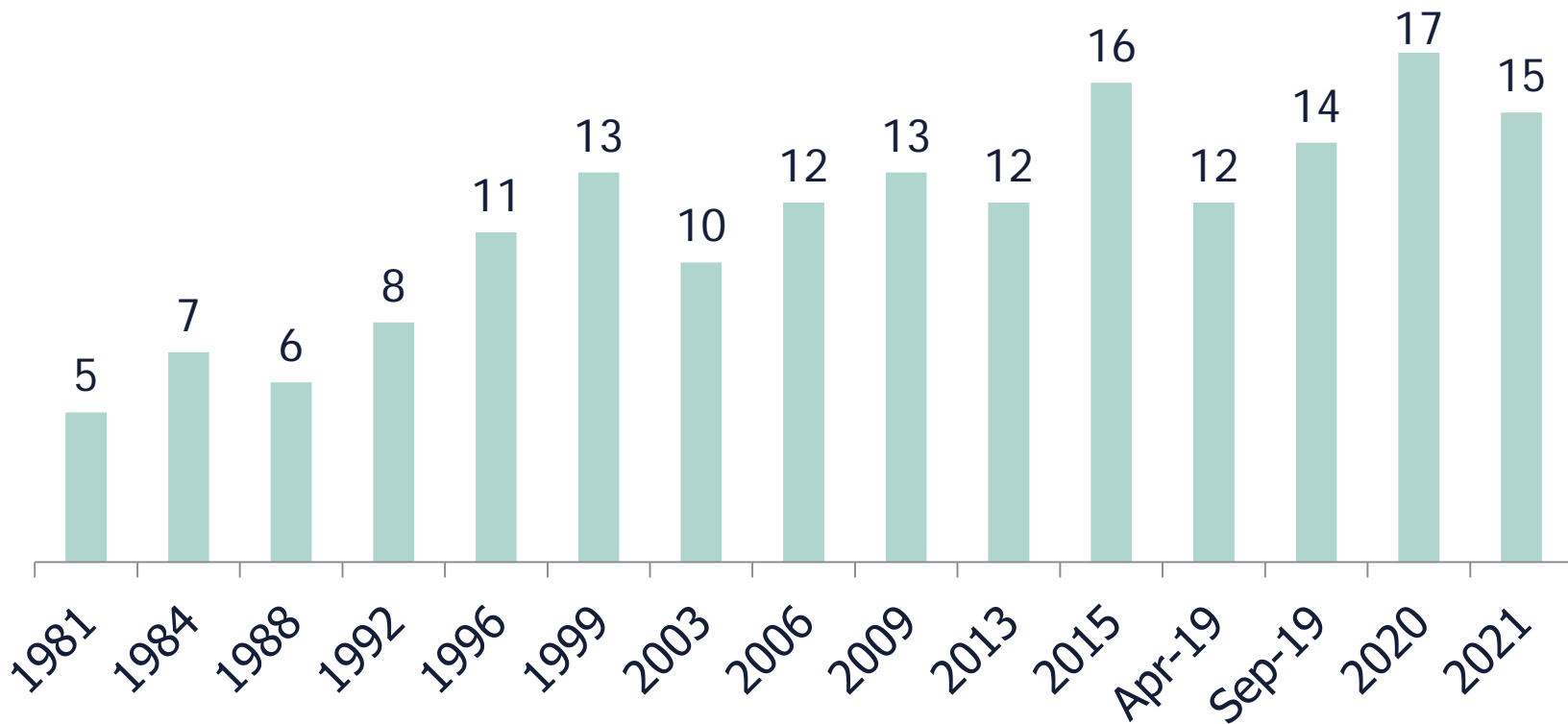
