In the survey, which was conducted on the internet and by telephone (supplements of groups that are not sufficiently represented on the network) from 18-19 October 2023, 507 men and women were interviewed in Hebrew and 103 in Arabic, constituting a representative national sample of the entire adult population of Israel aged 18 and older.
