Flash Survey on the Agreement to End the War and Release the Hostages was prepared by the Viterbi Center for Public Opinion and Policy Research of the Israel Democracy Institute. In the survey, which was conducted on the internet between 19-21 October, 2025, 600 men and women were interviewed in Hebrew and 148 in Arabic, constituting a representative national sample of the entire adult population of Israel aged 18 and older. The maximum sampling error for the entire sample was $\pm 3.58\%$ at a confidence level of 95%. The fieldwork was done by the ipanel company.
